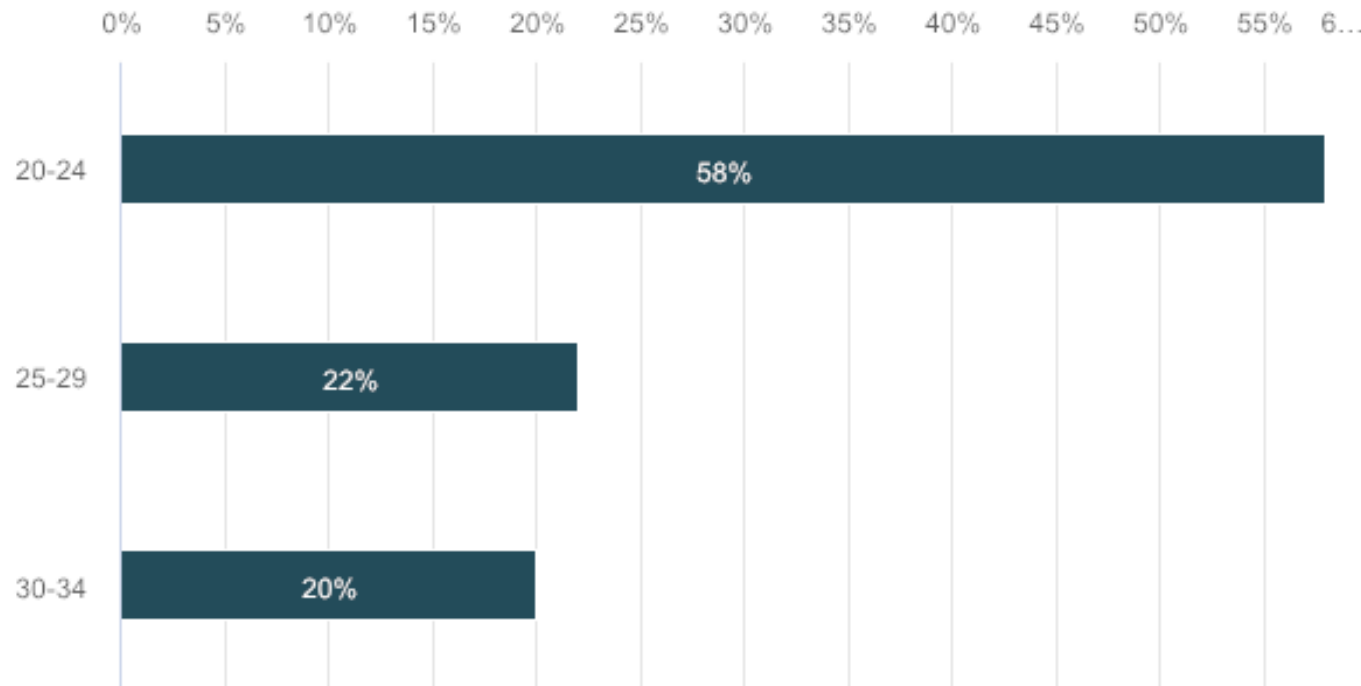

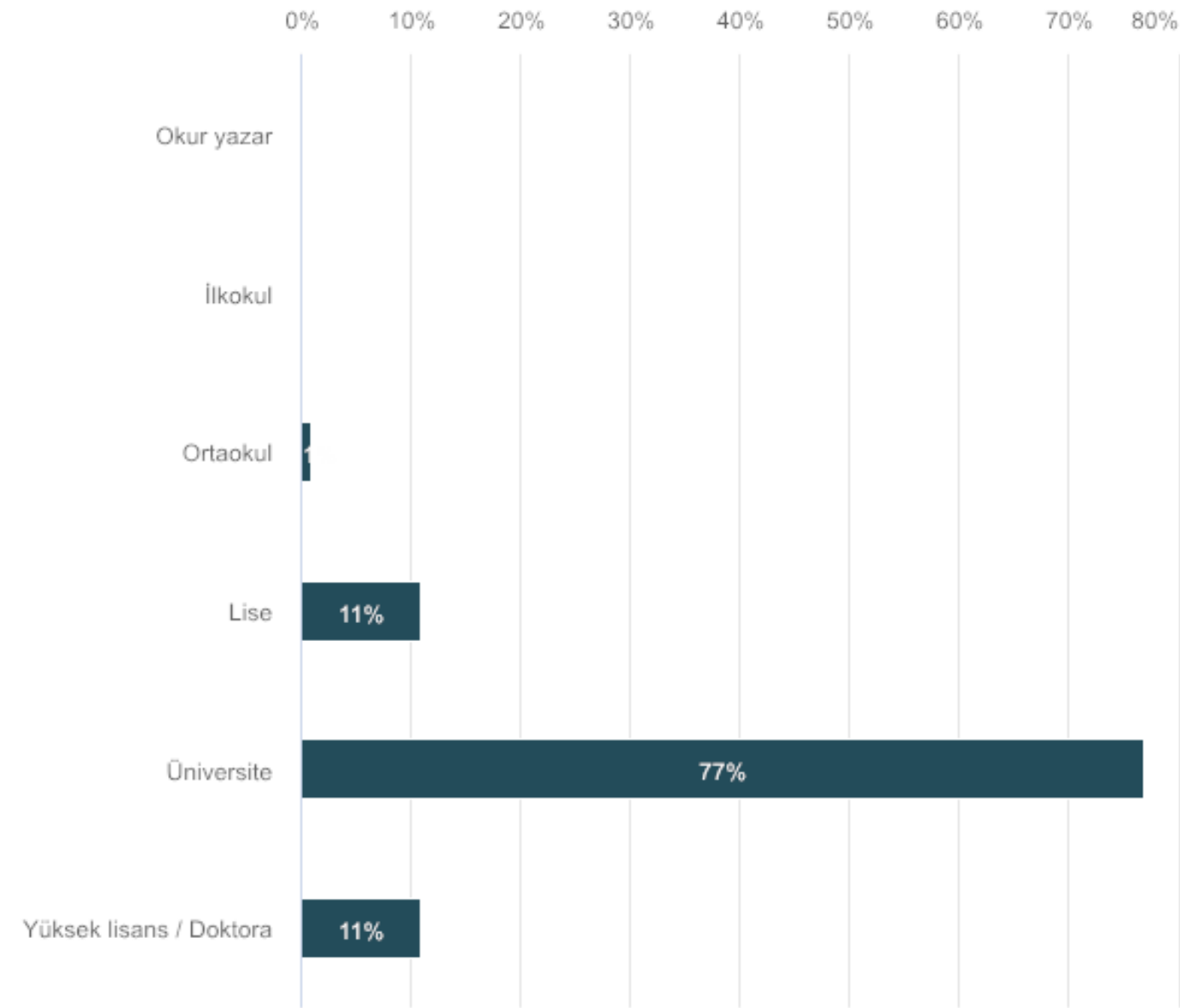

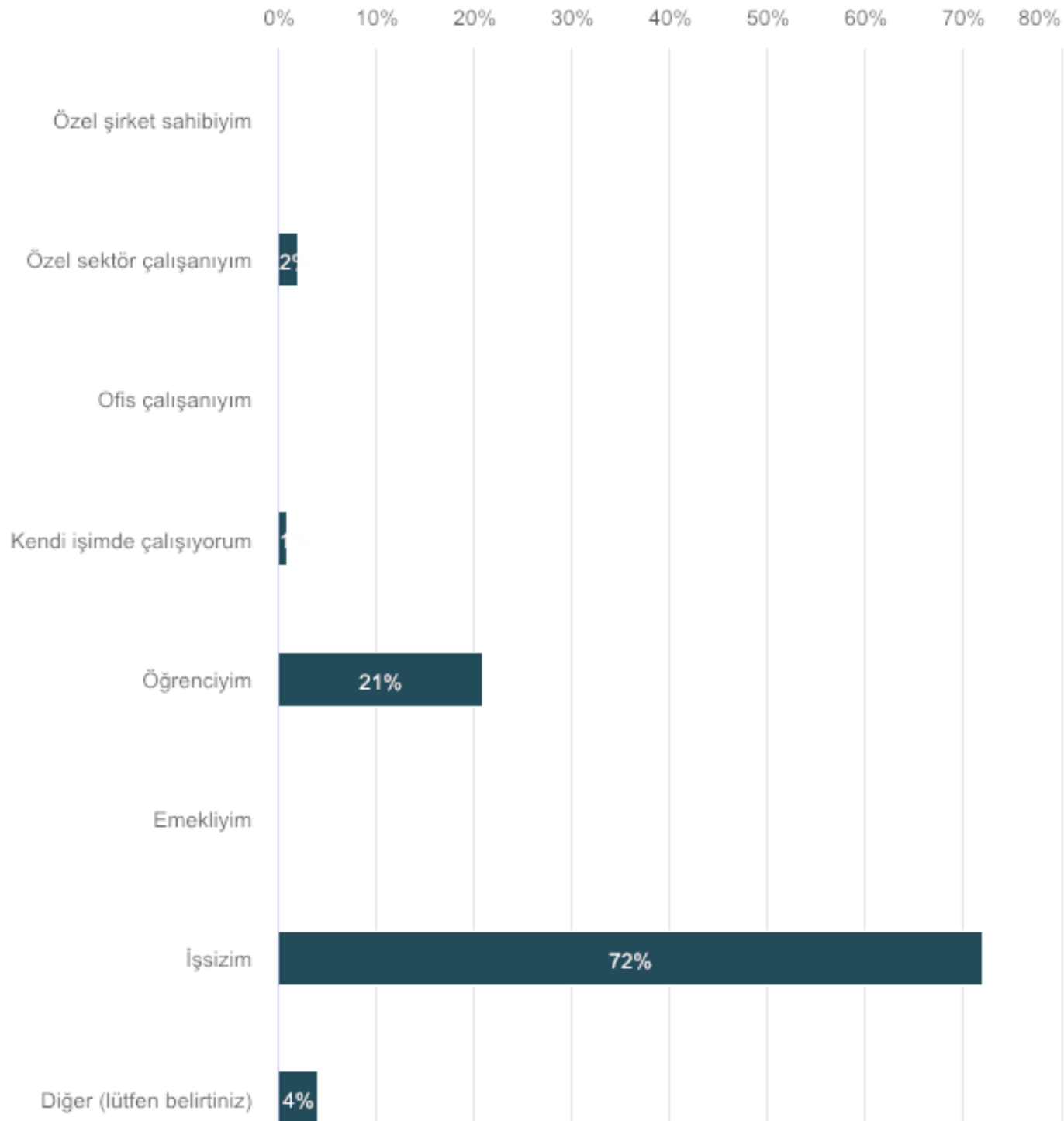

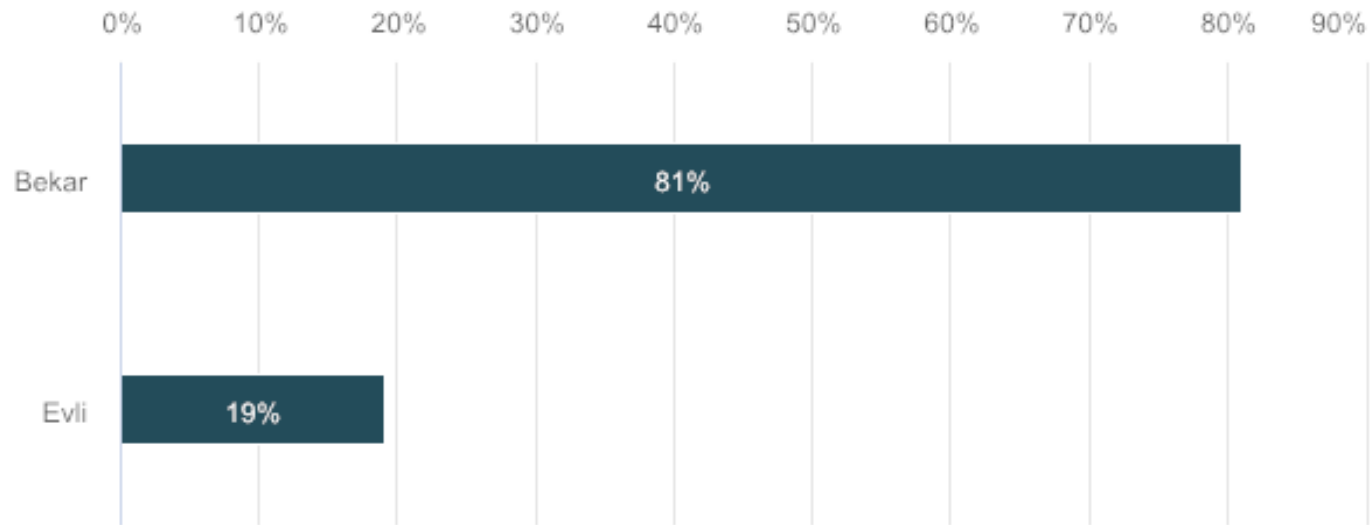

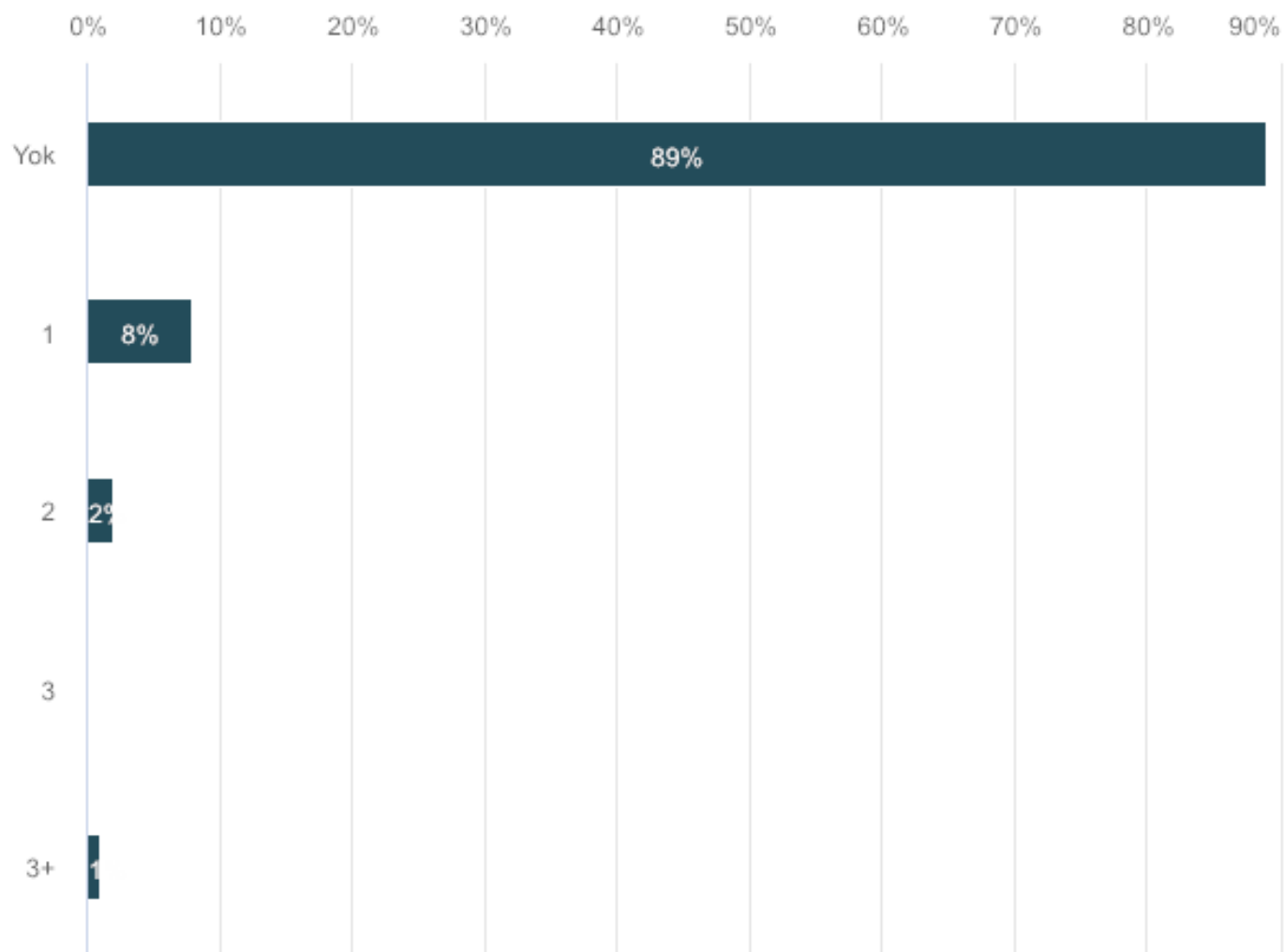

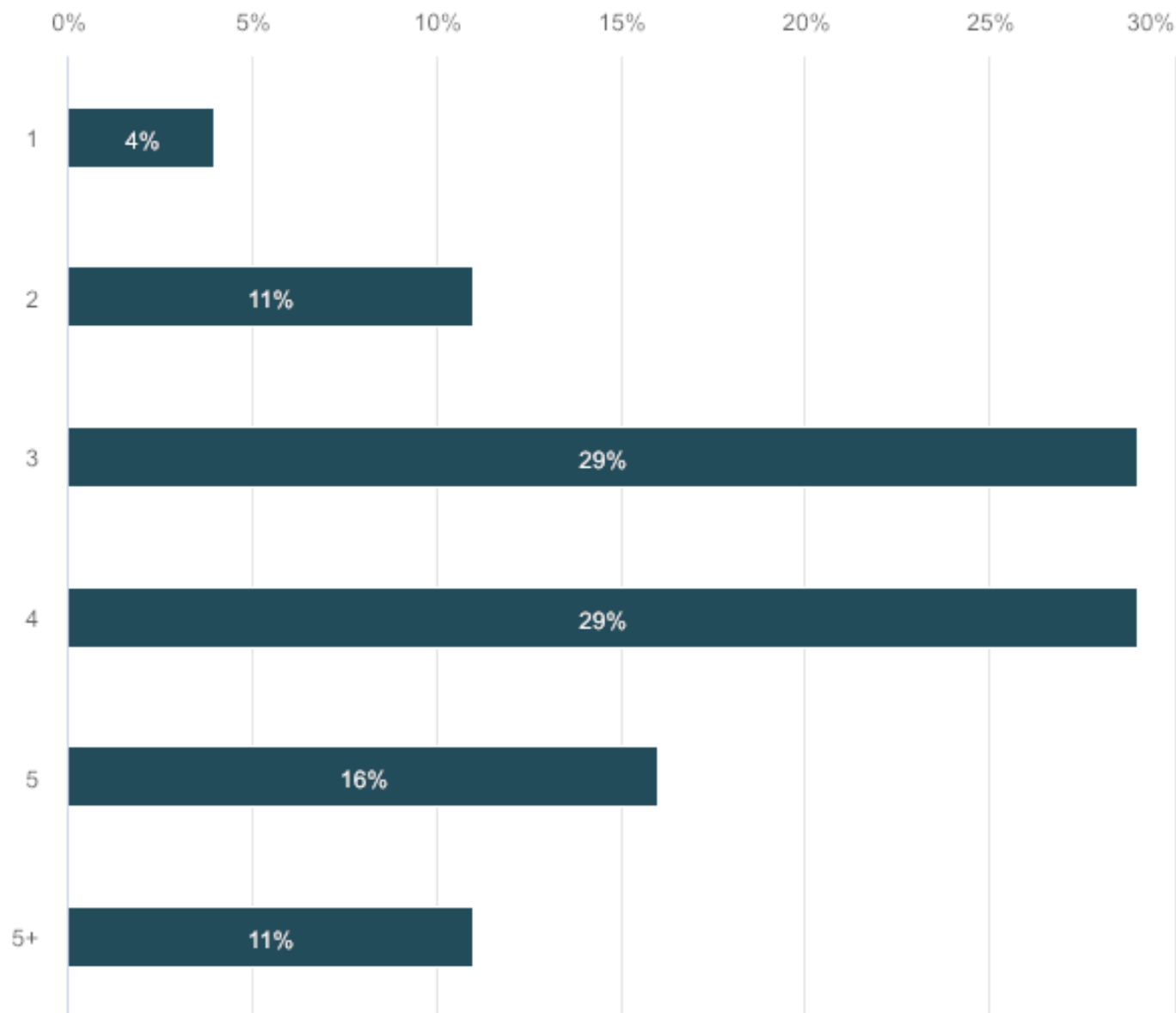

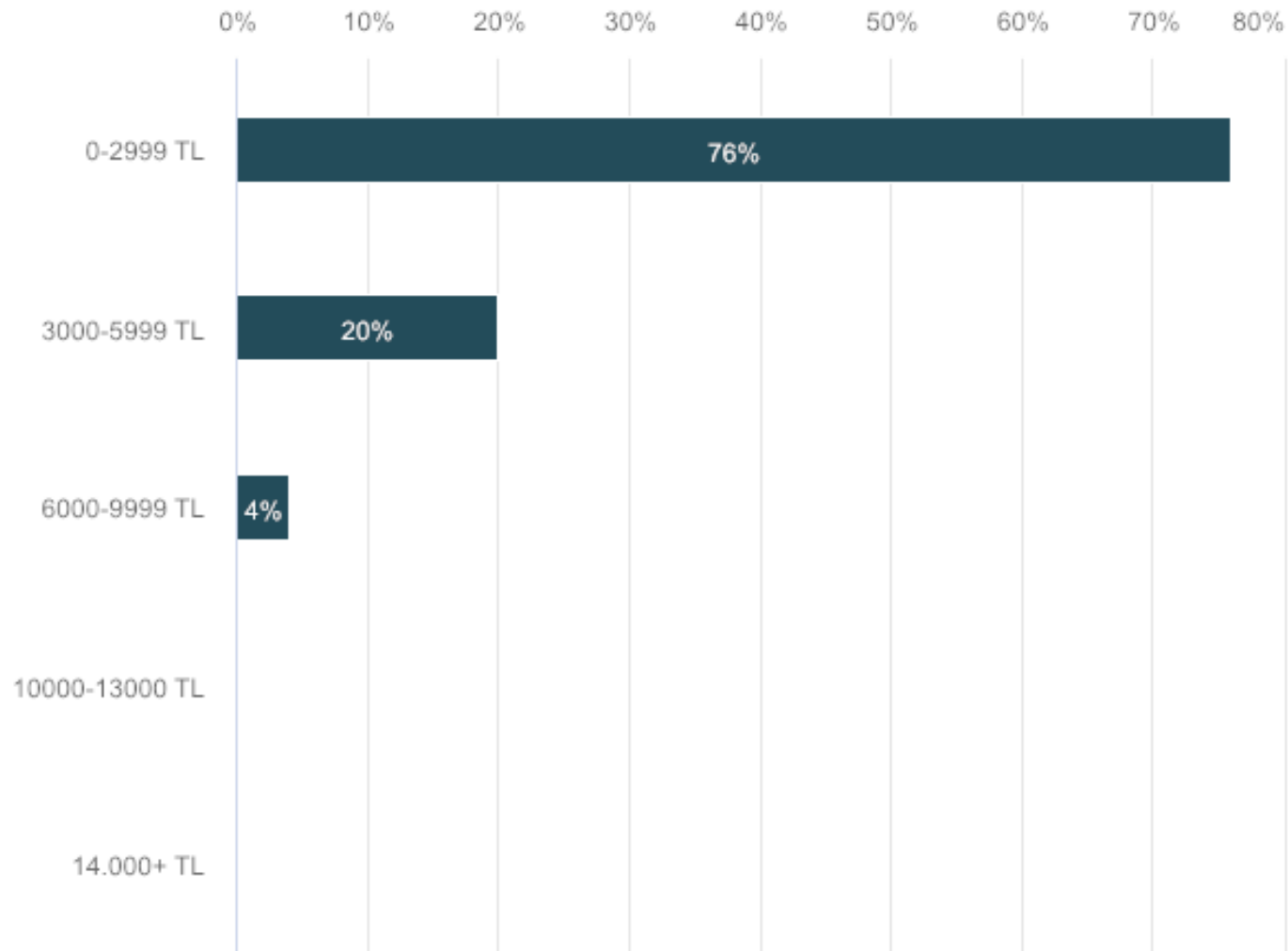

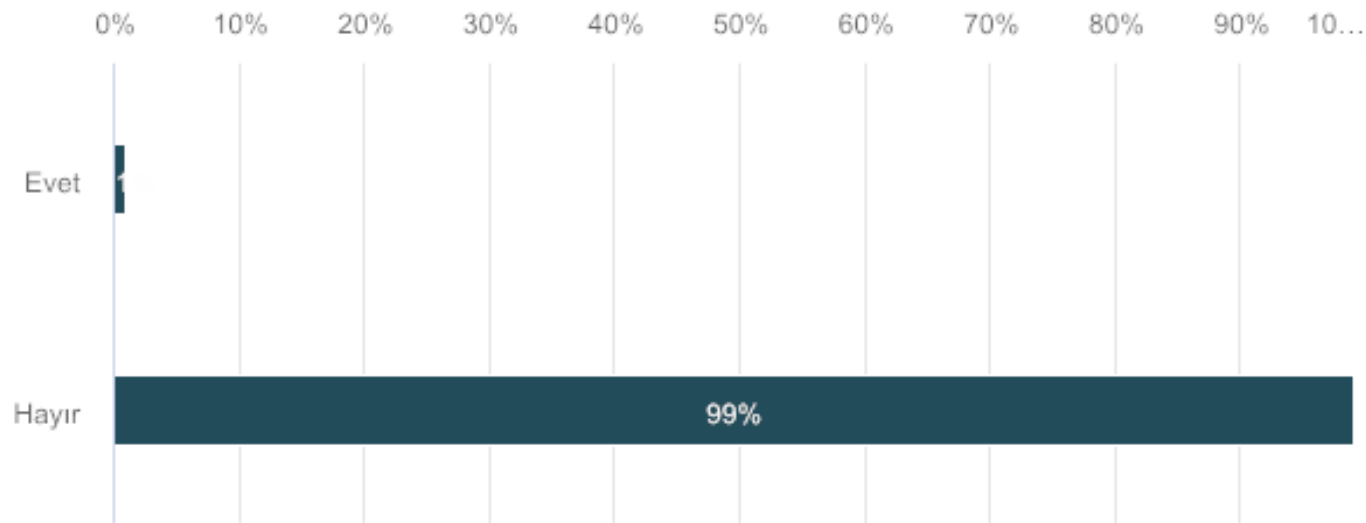

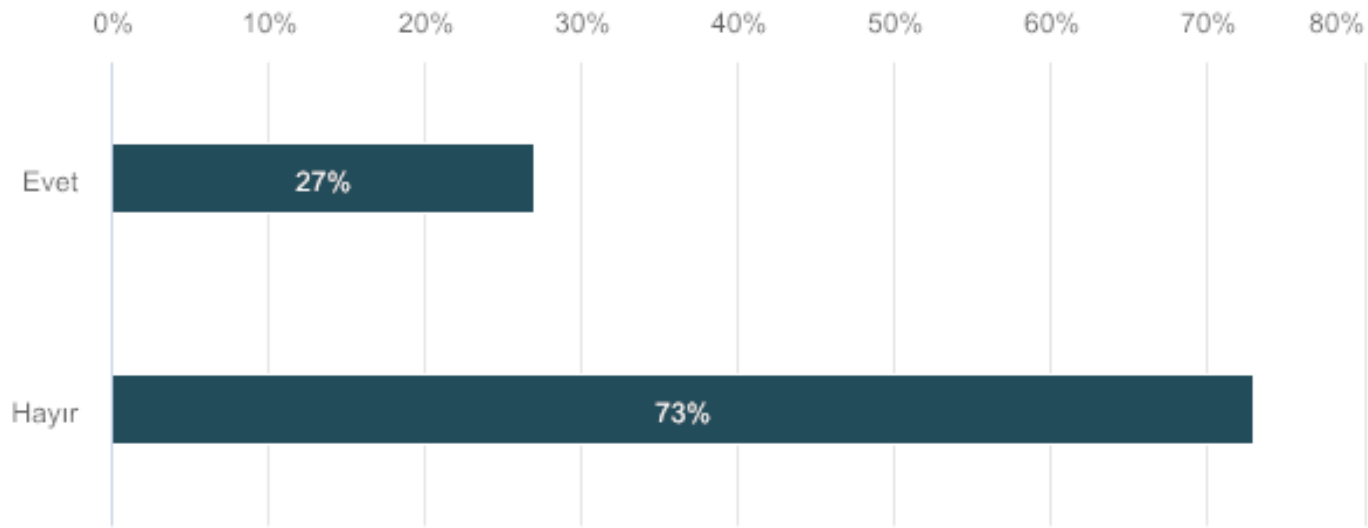

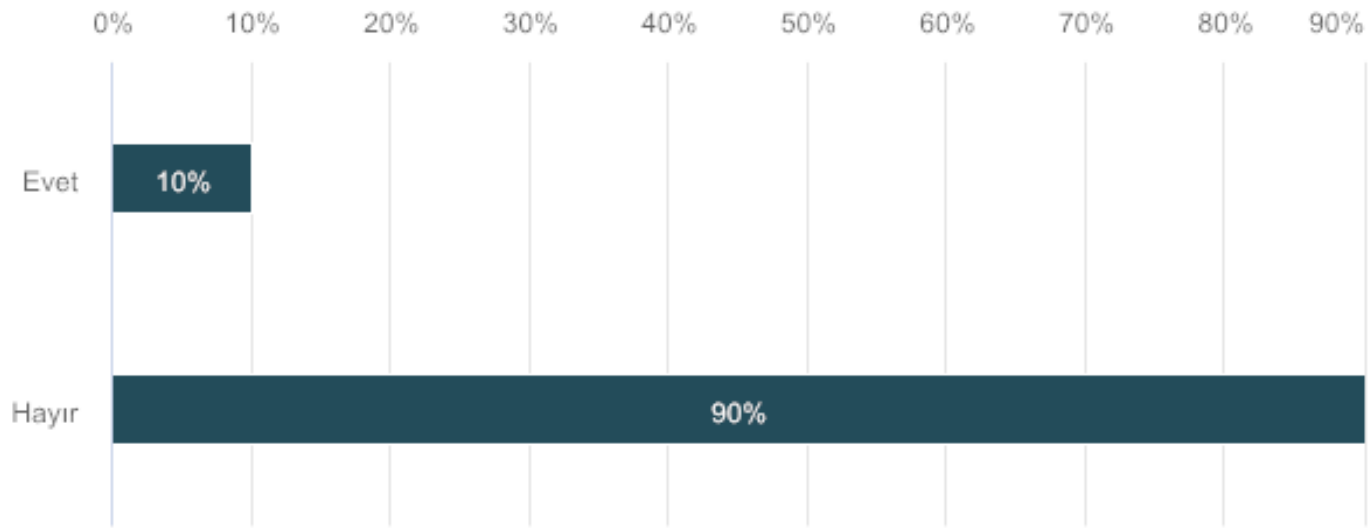

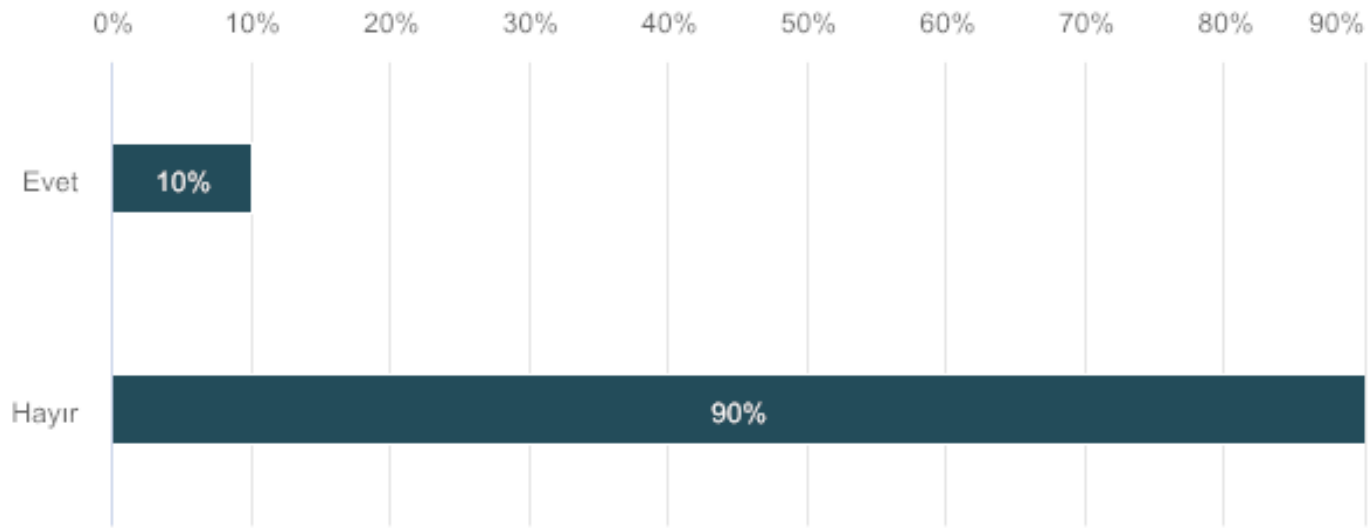

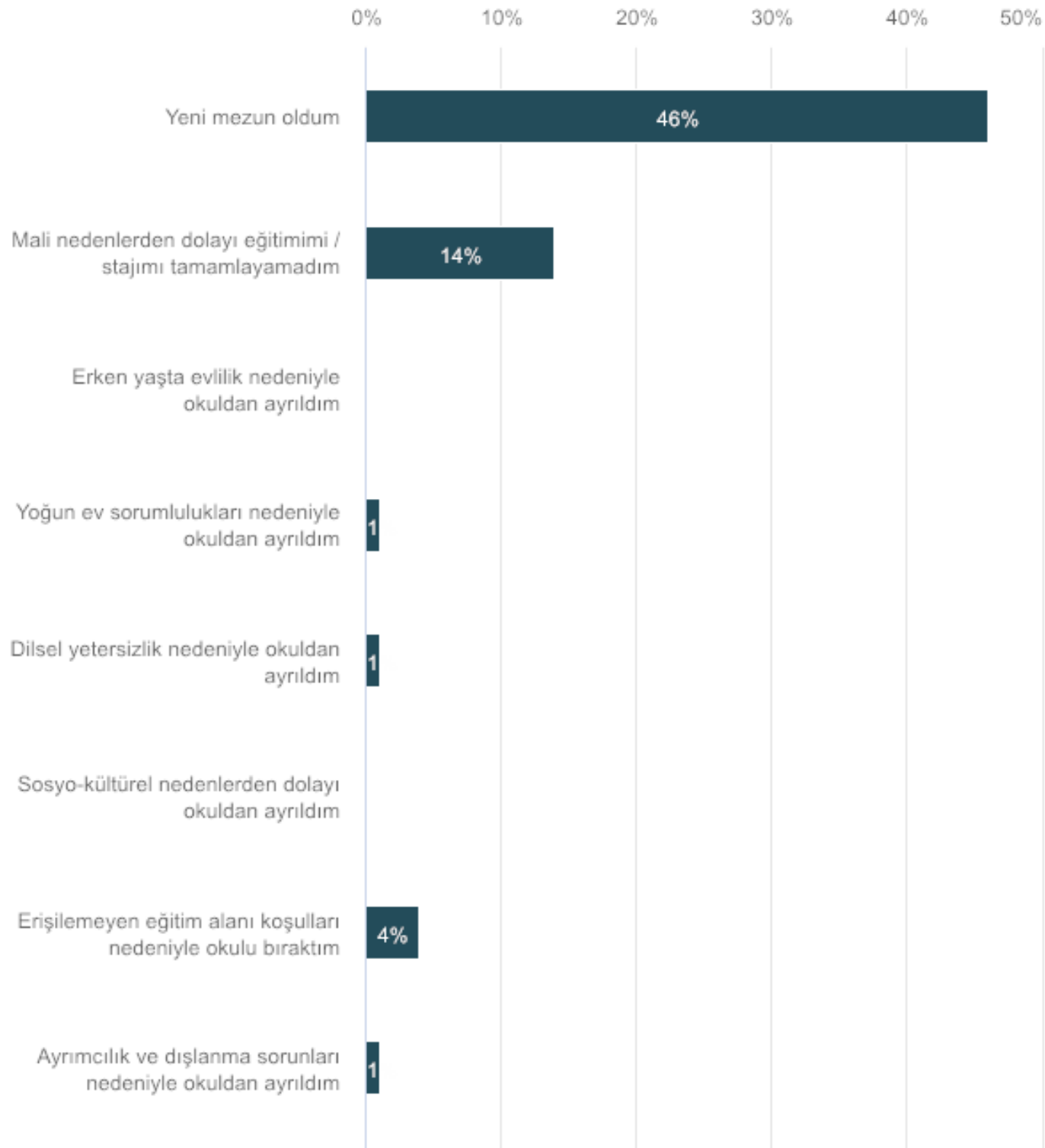

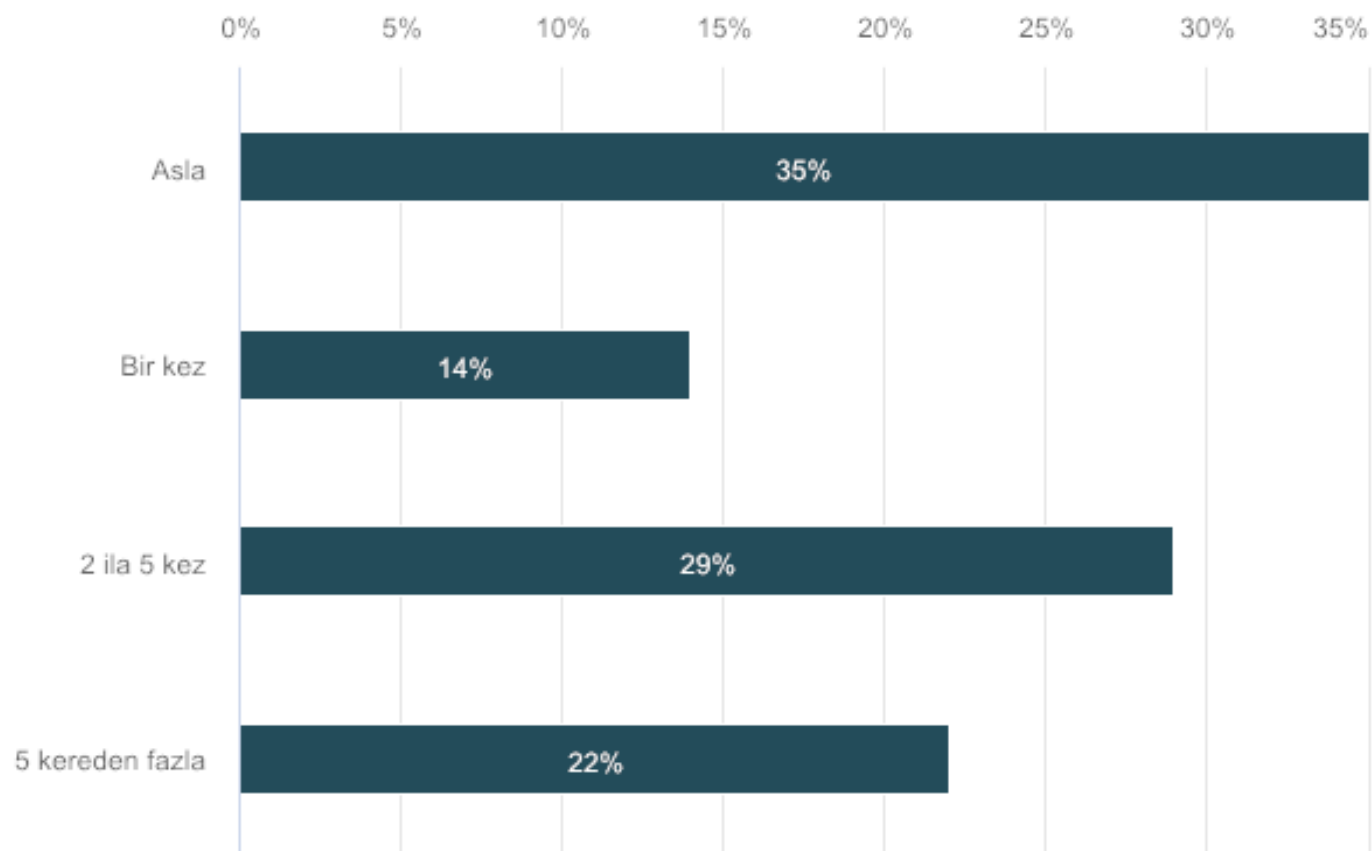

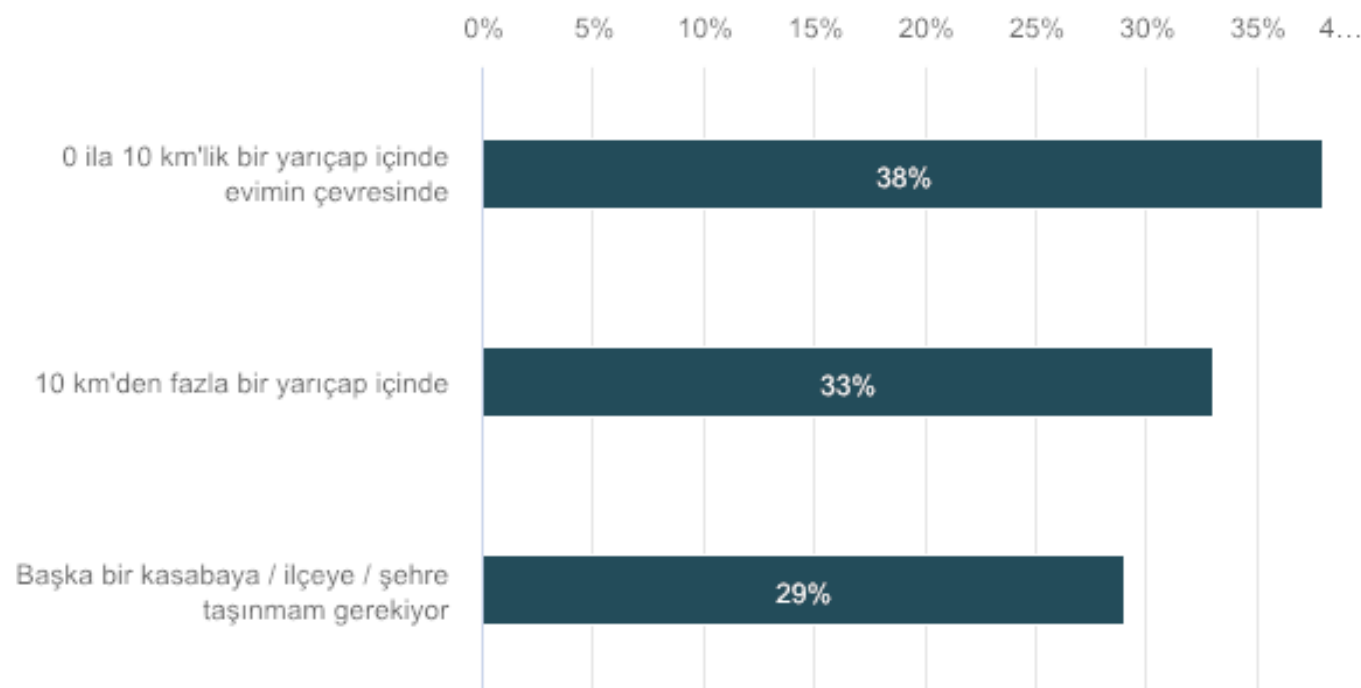

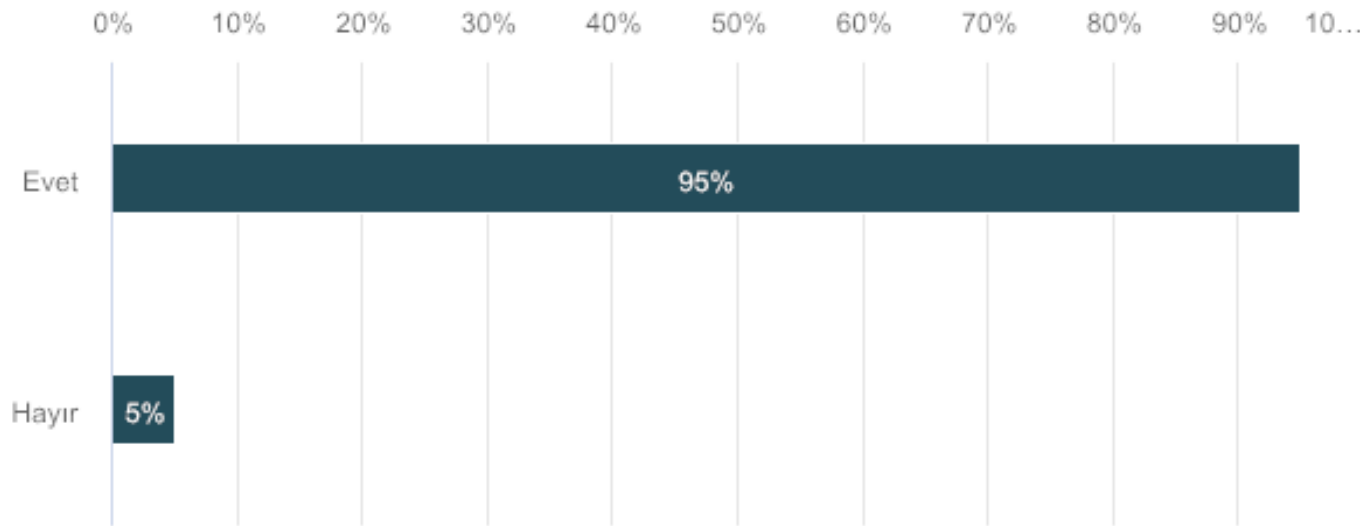

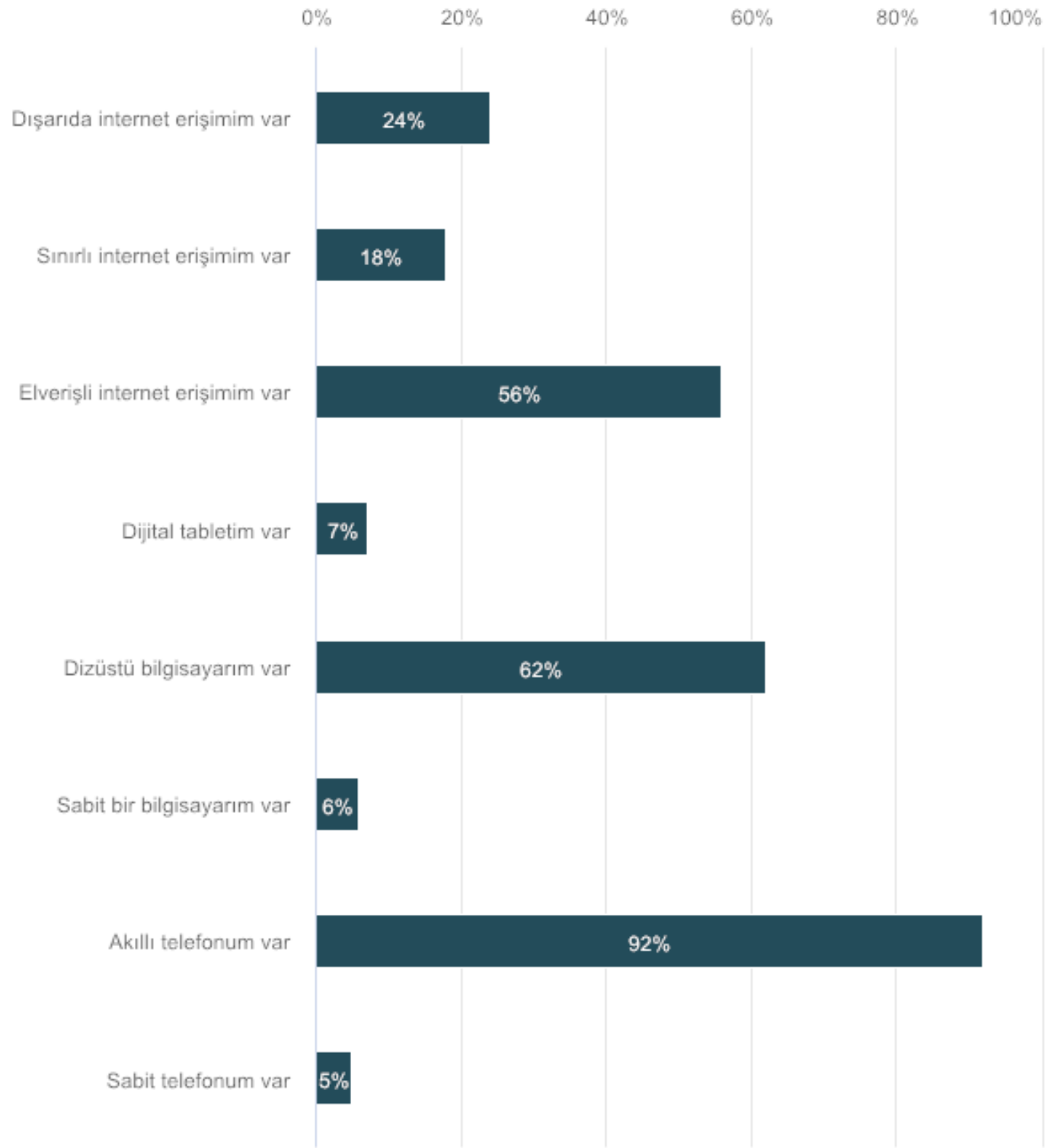

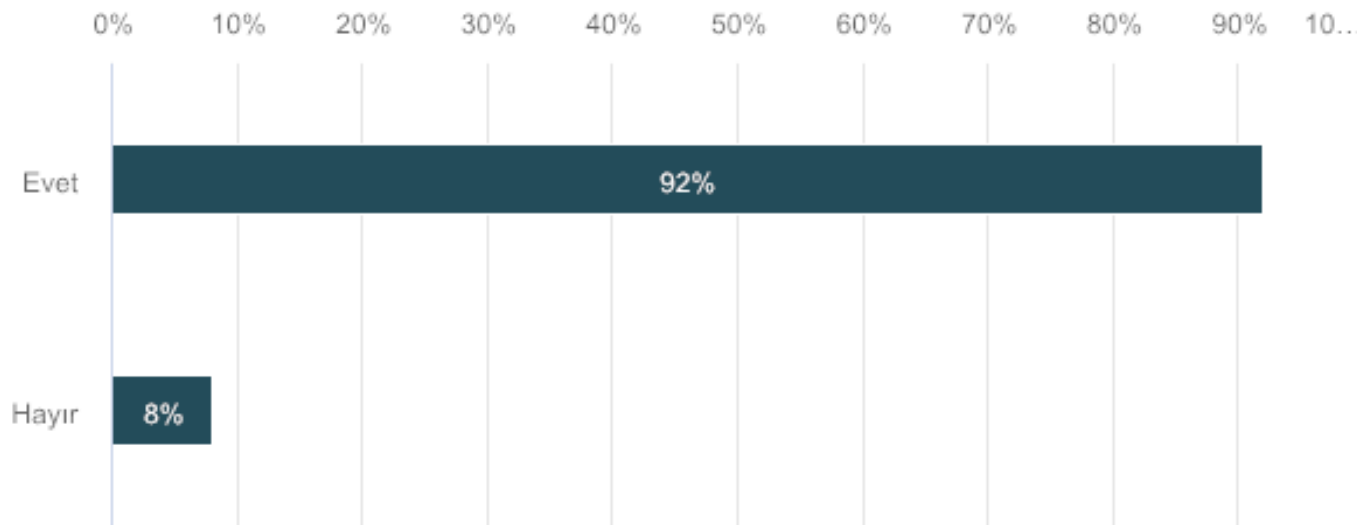

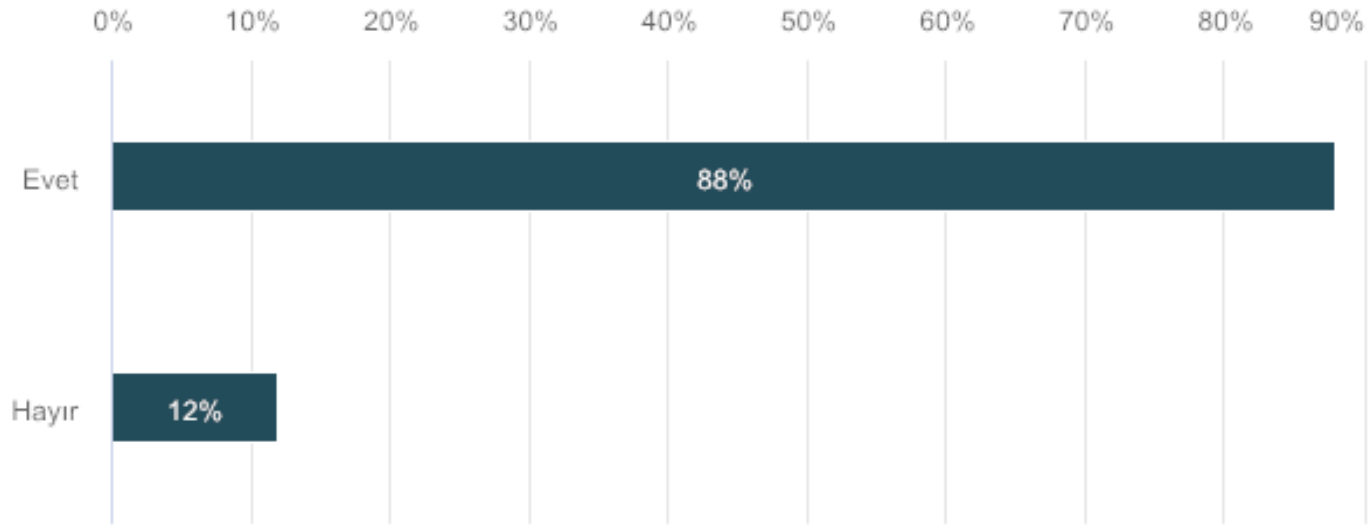

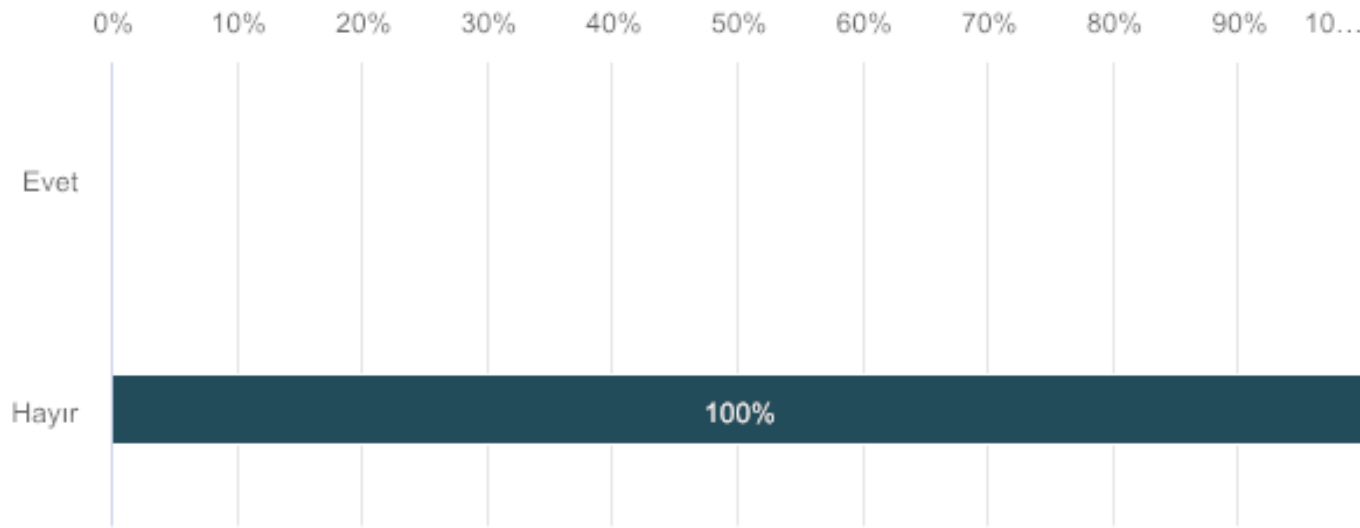

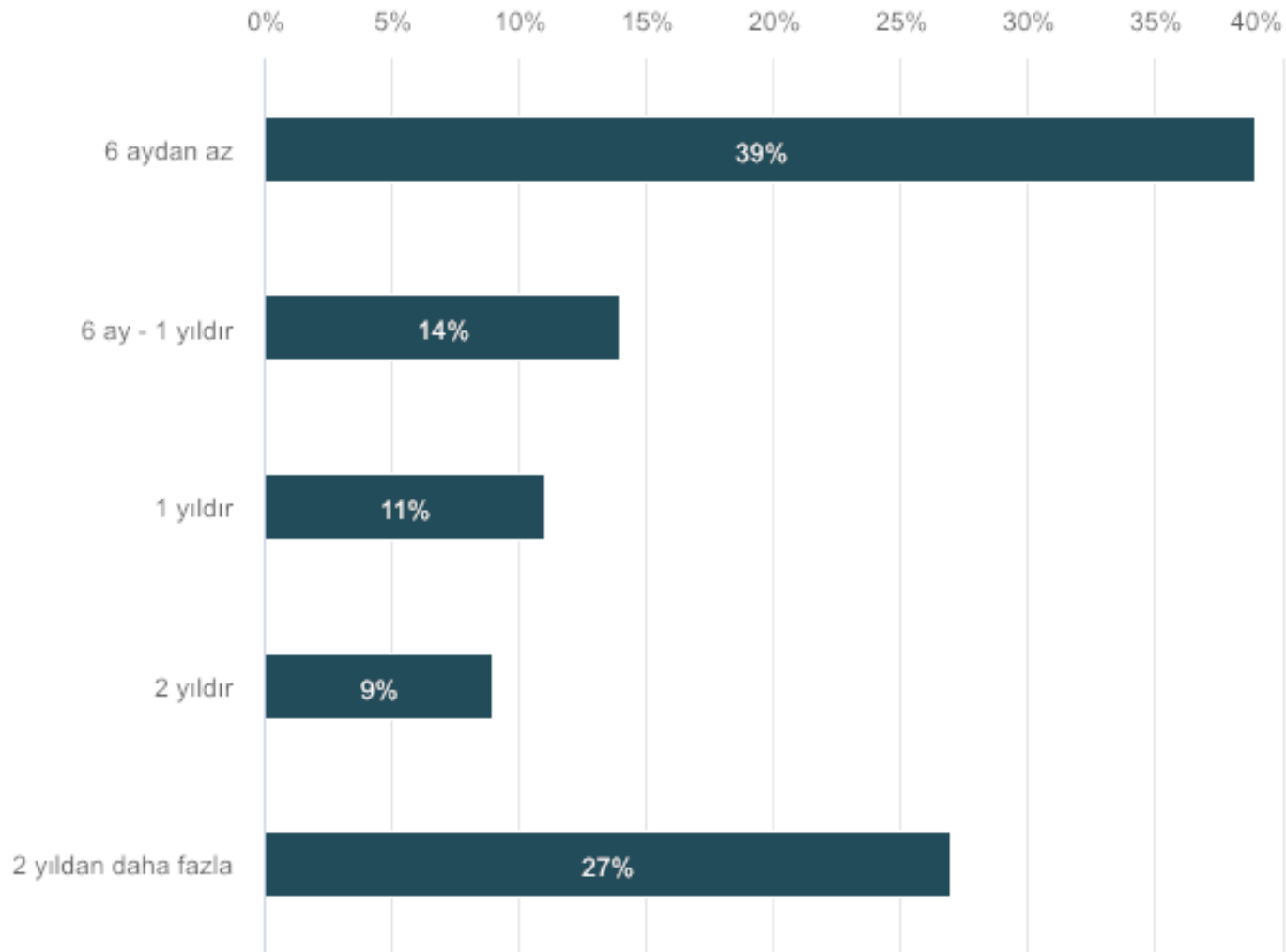

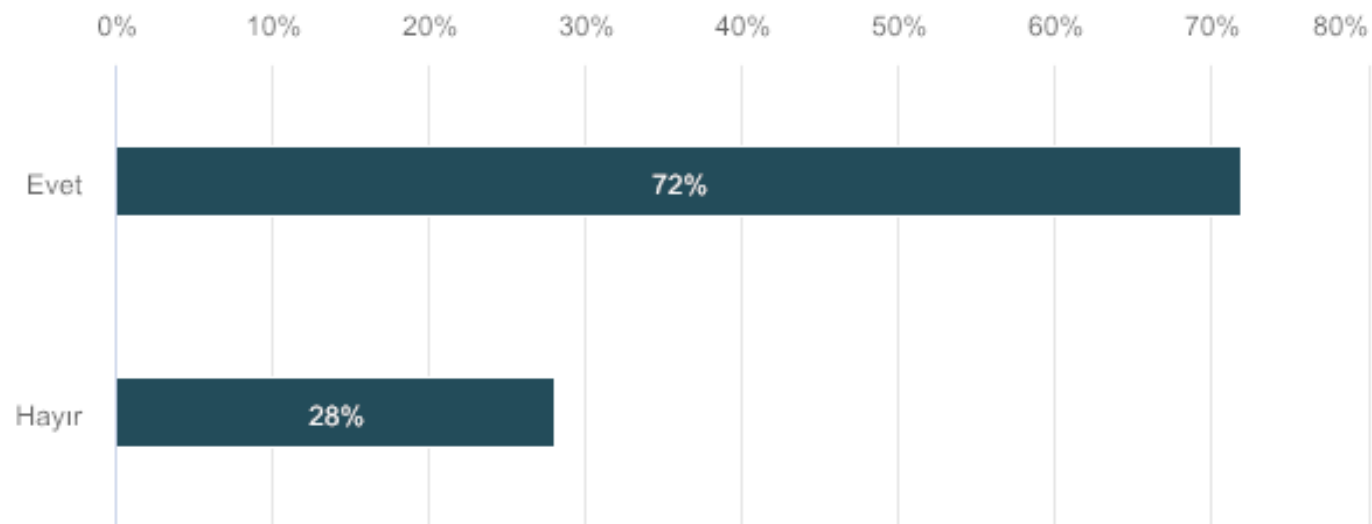

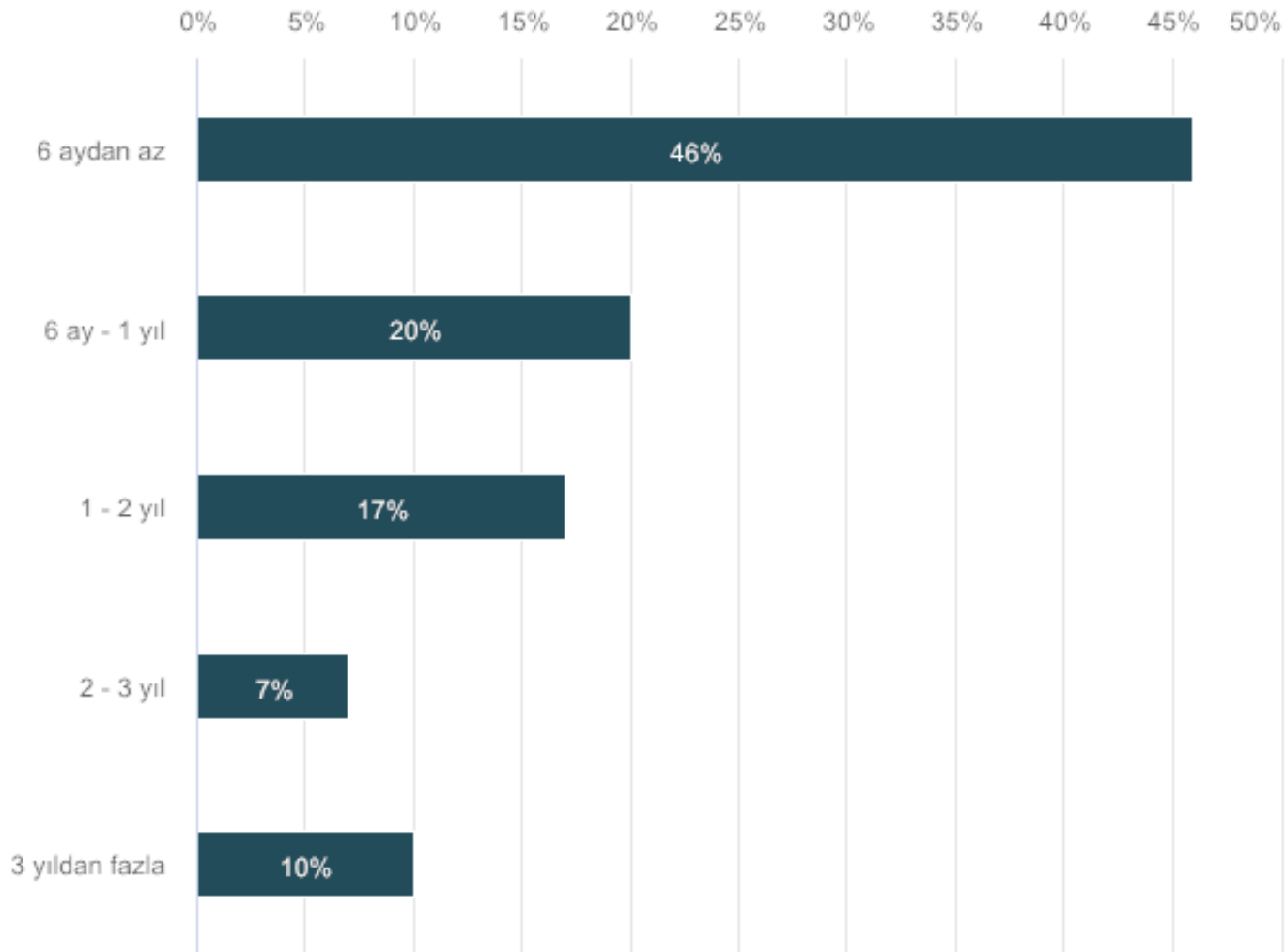

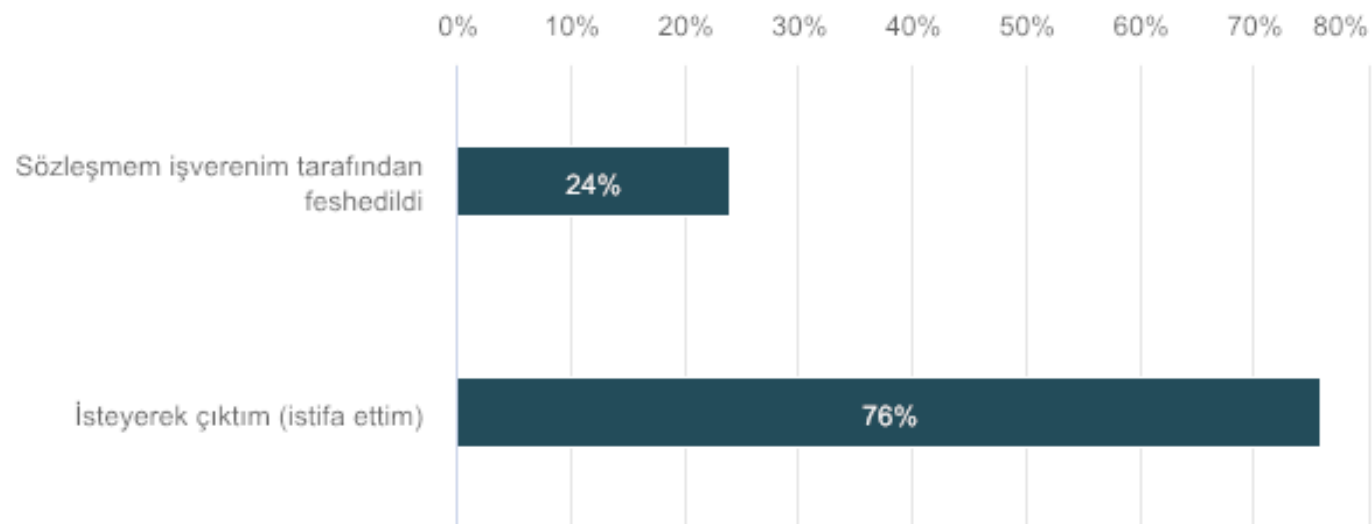

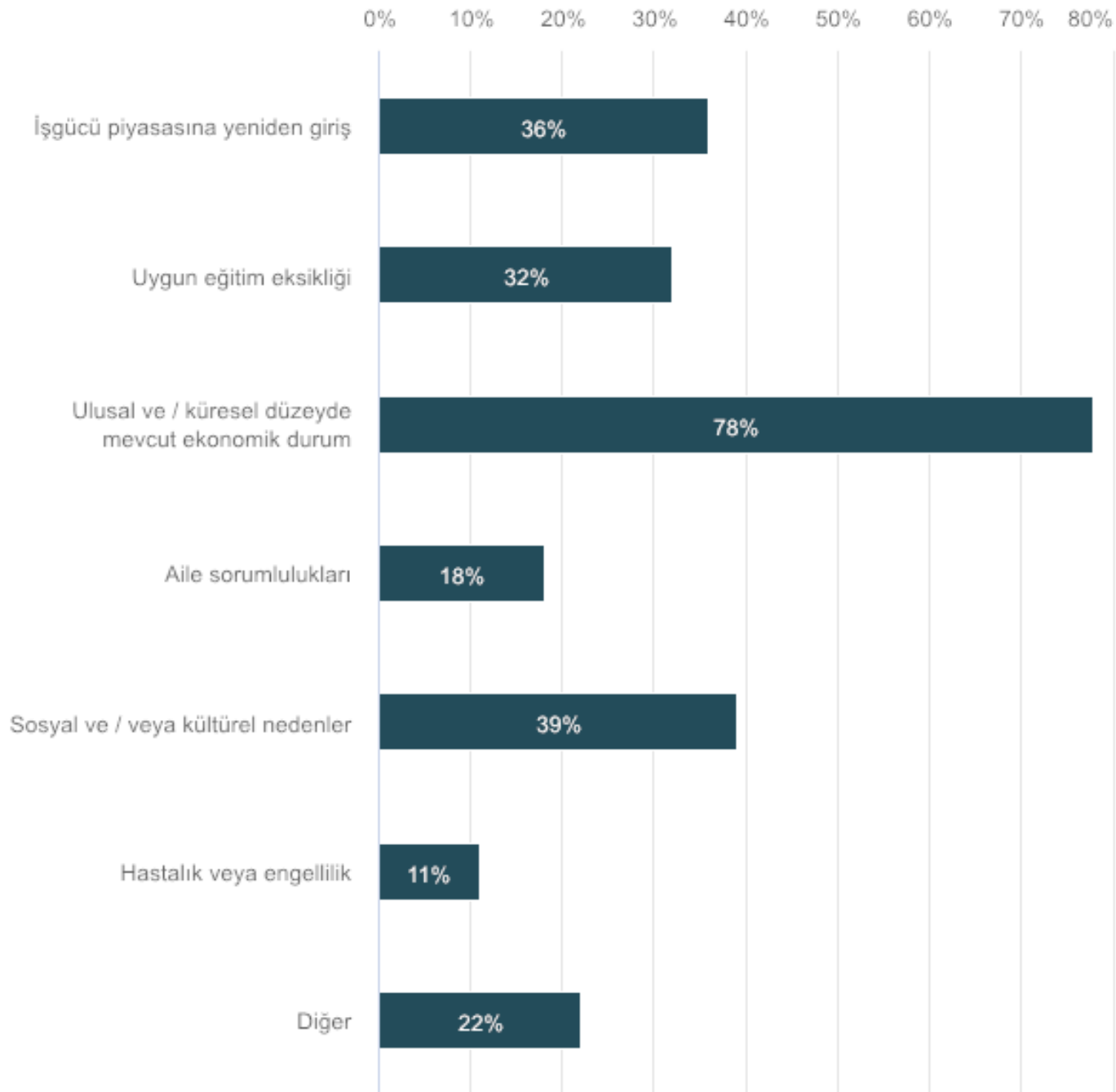

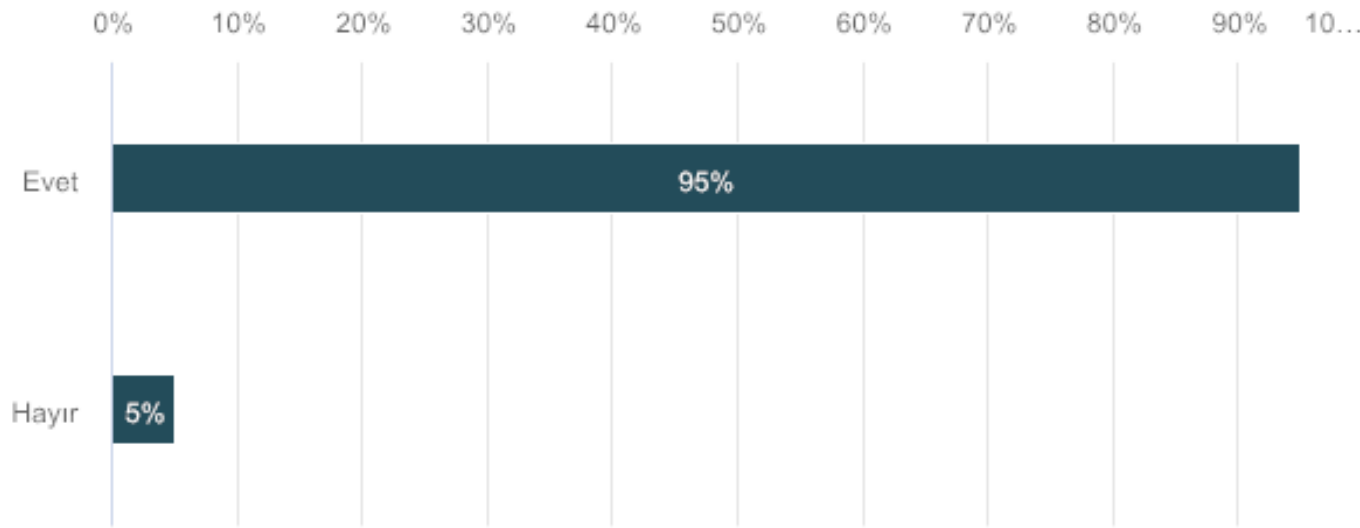

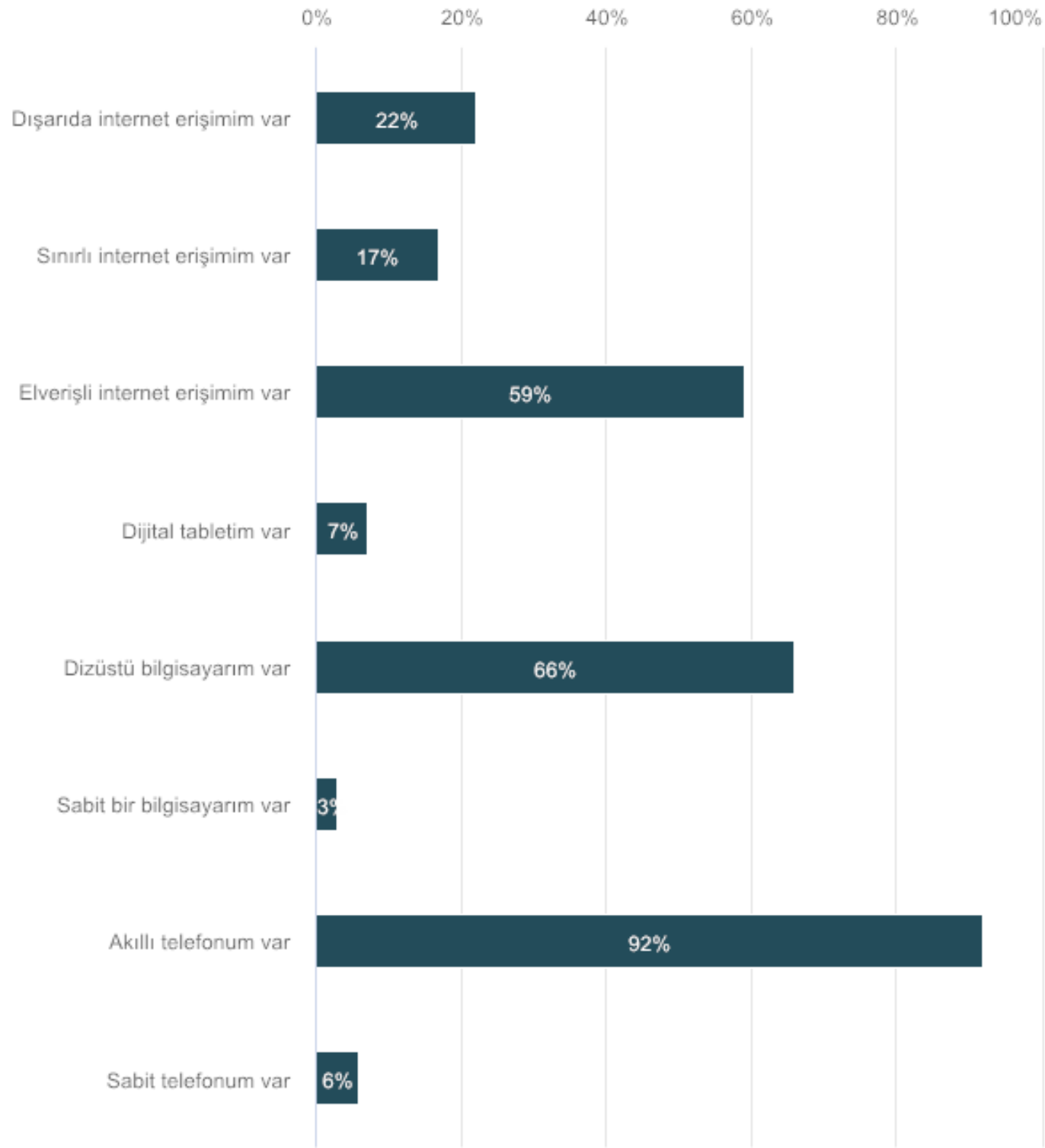

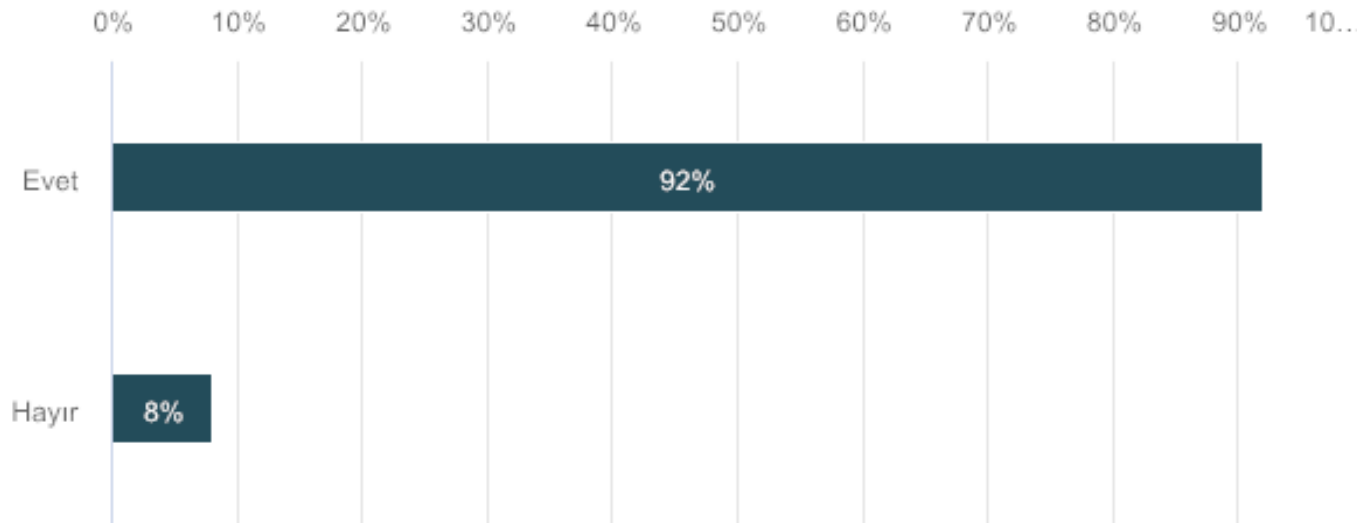

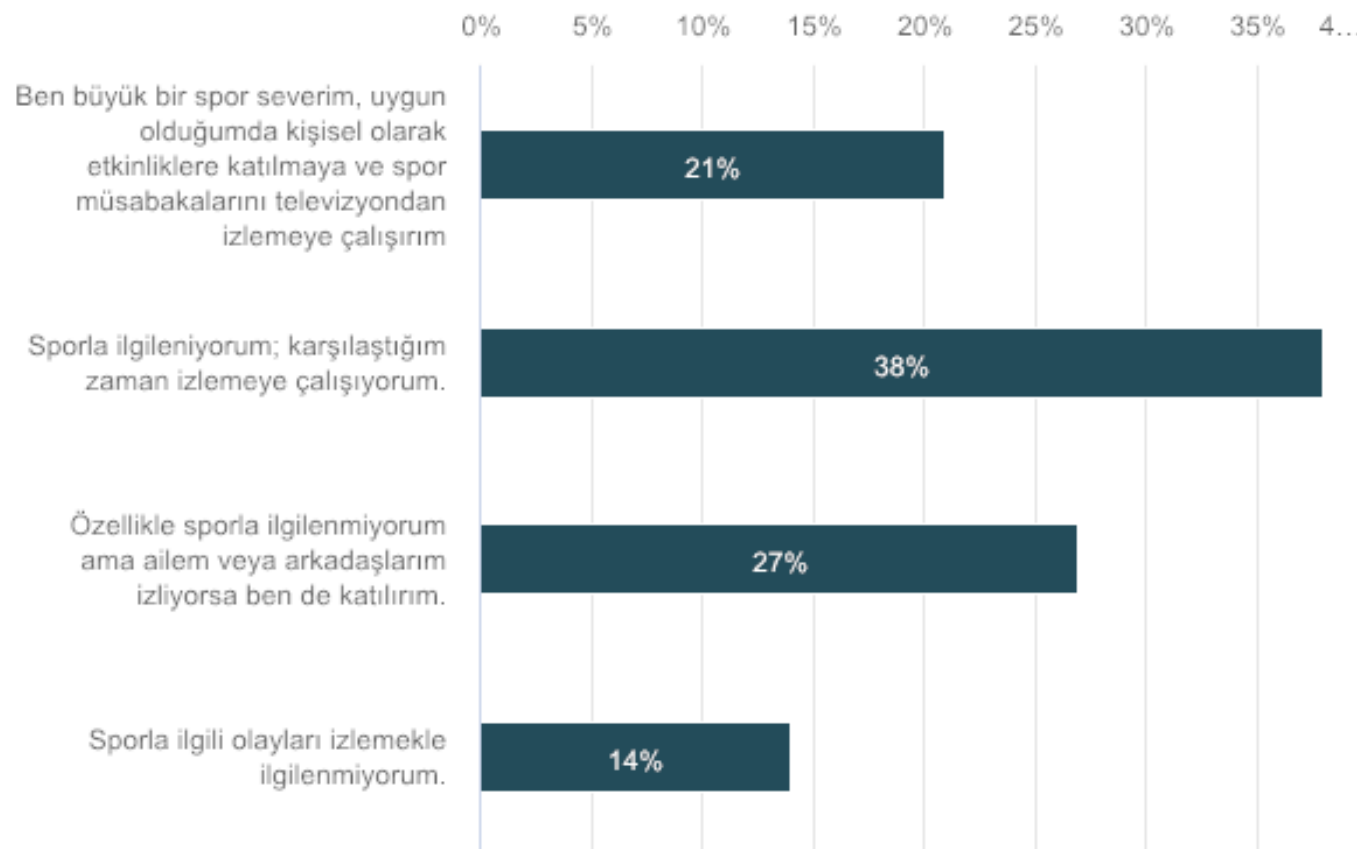

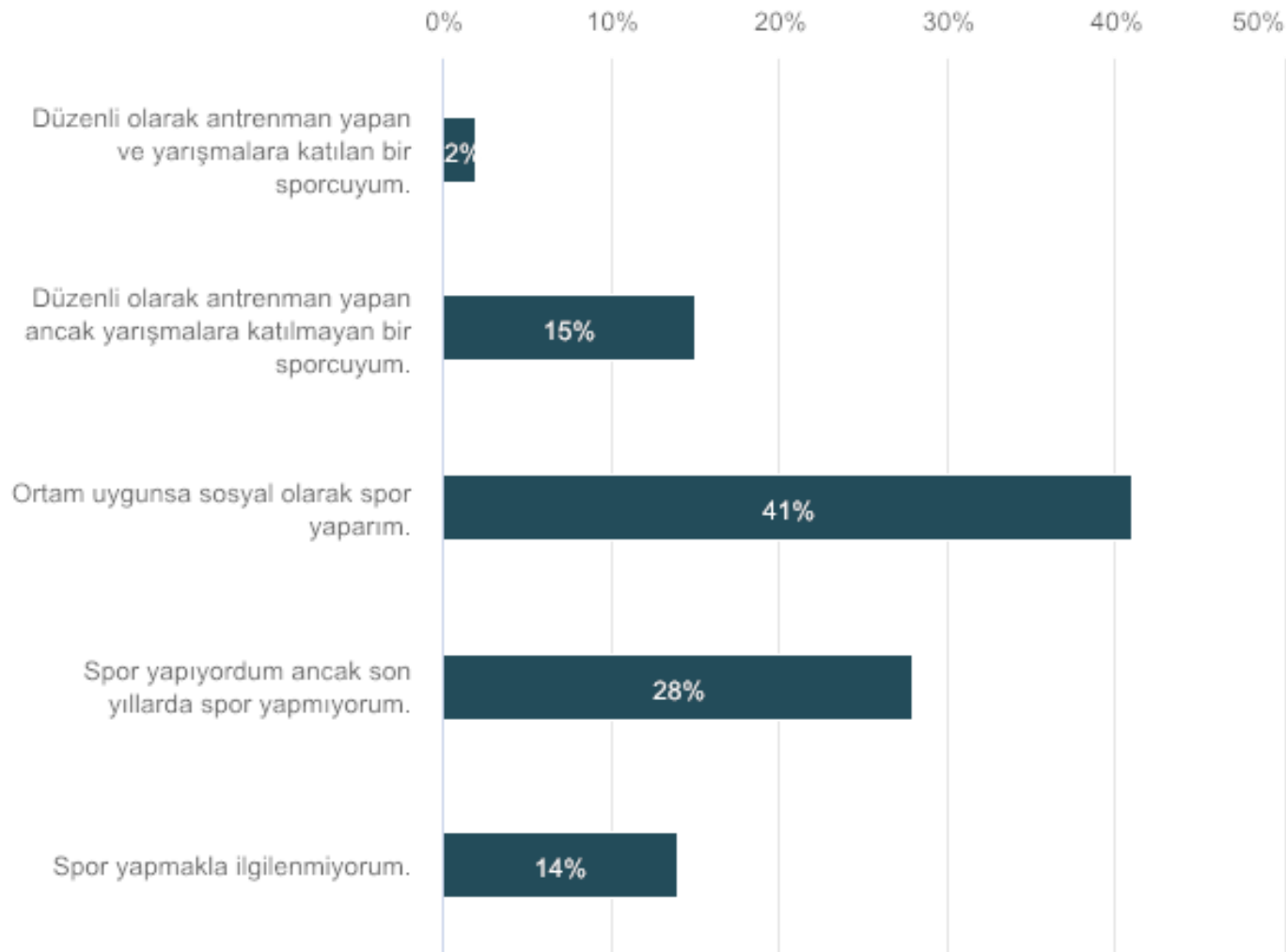

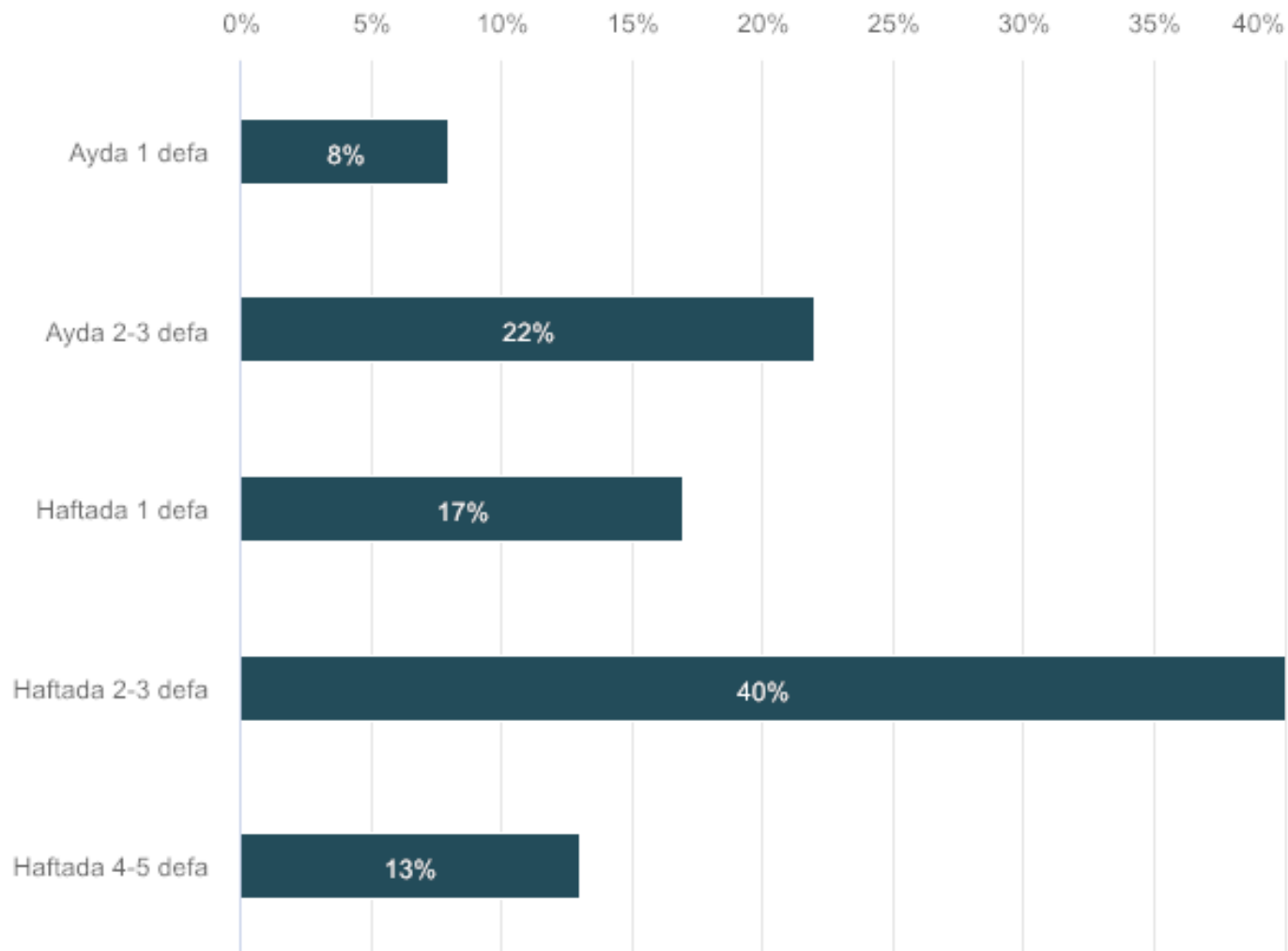

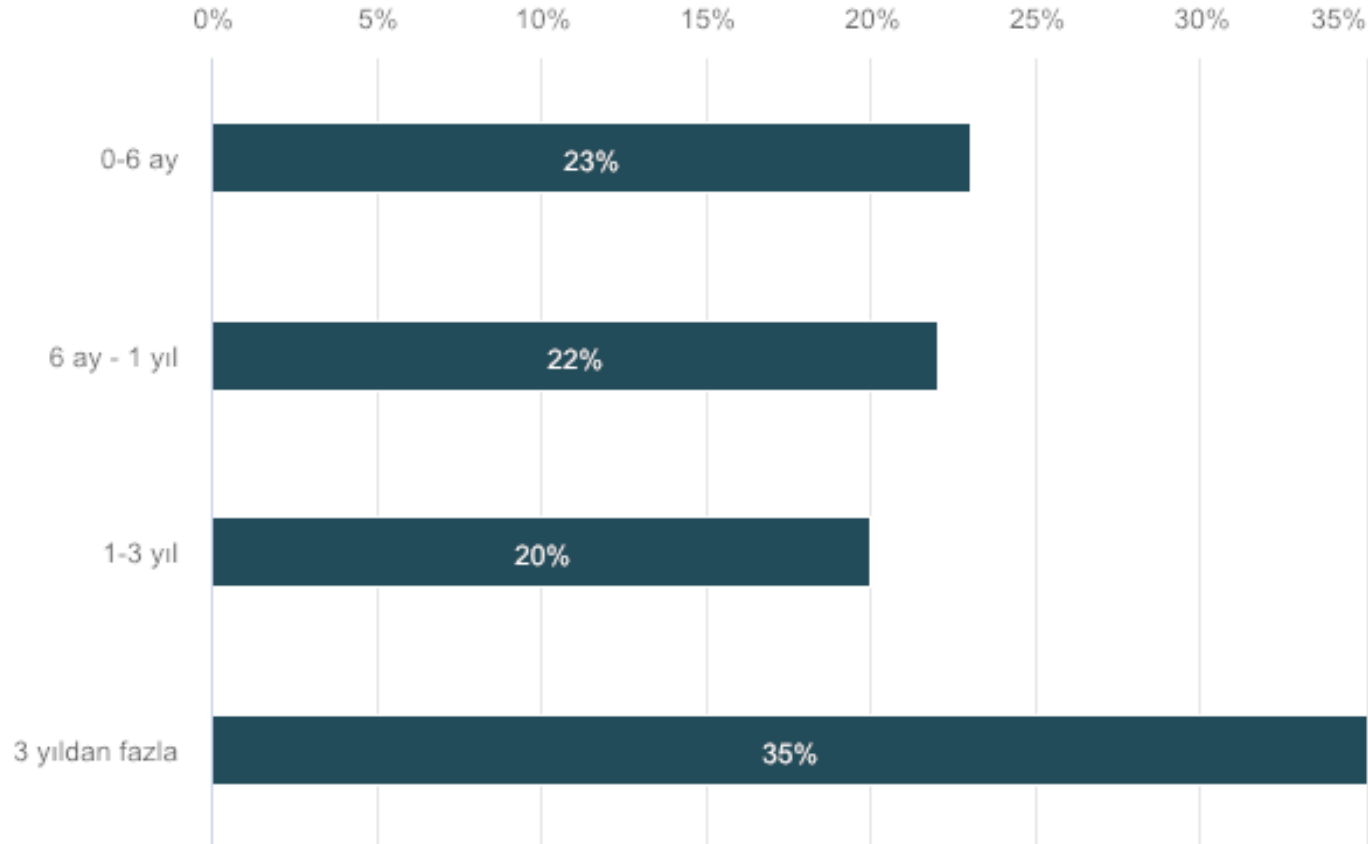

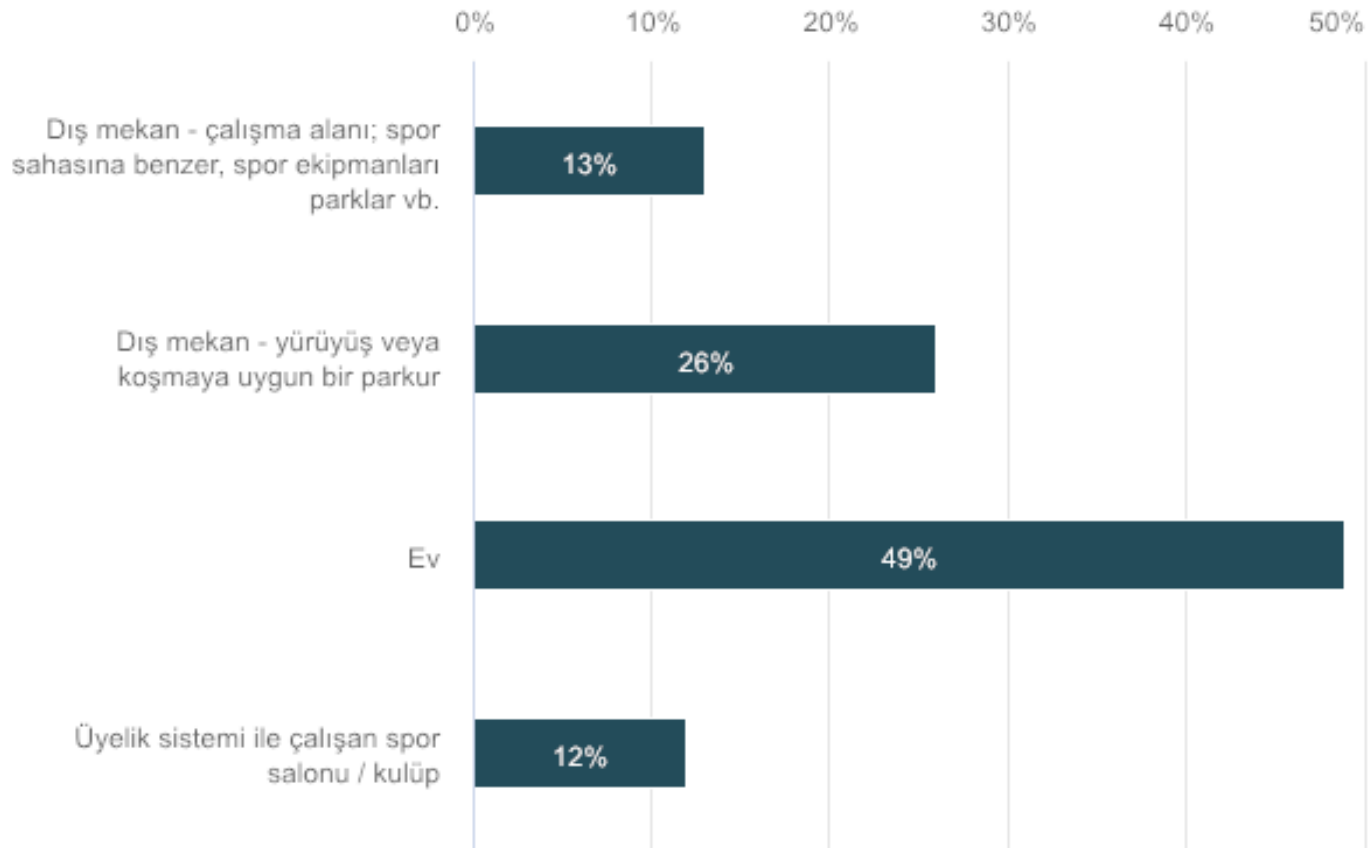

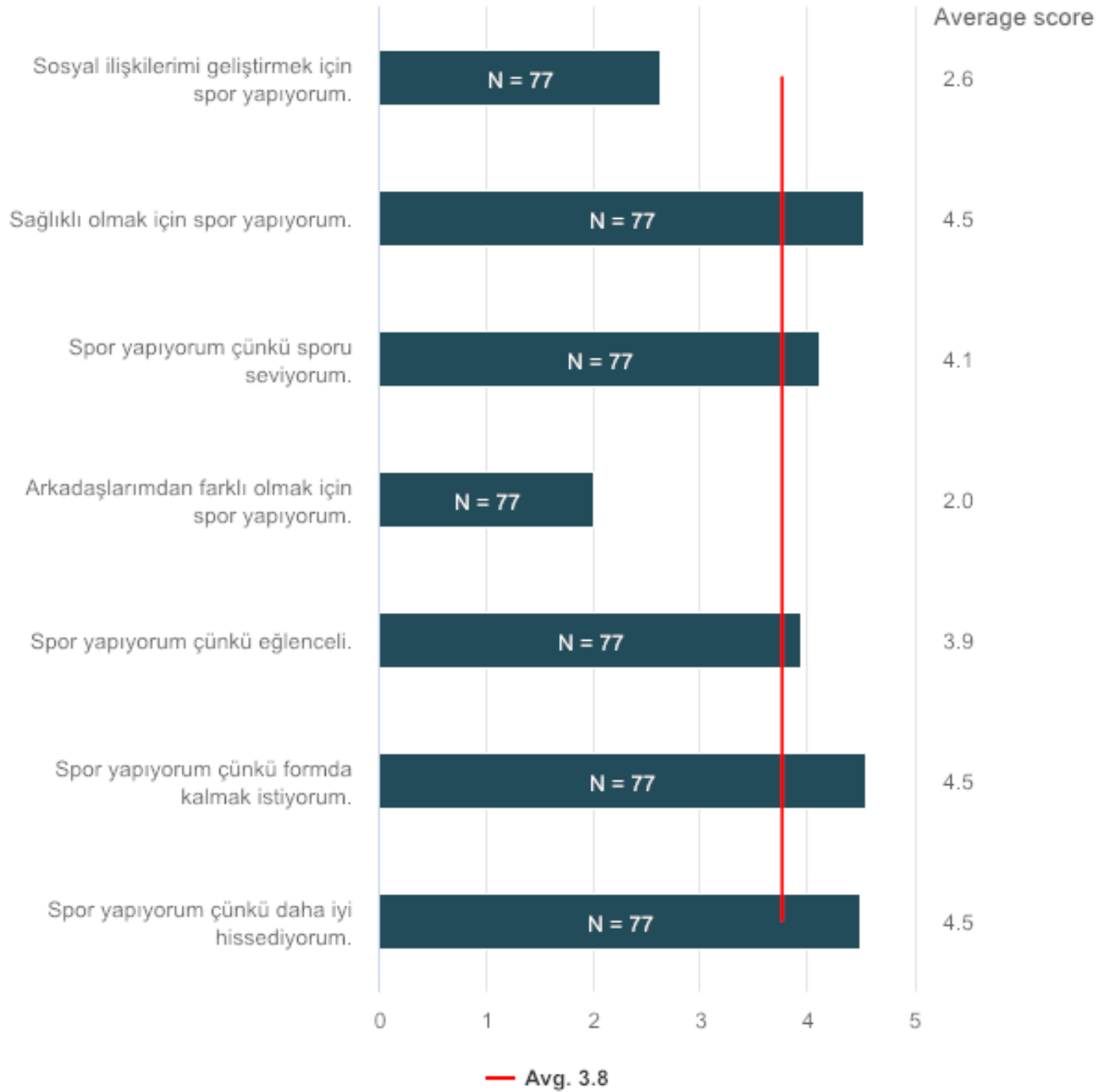

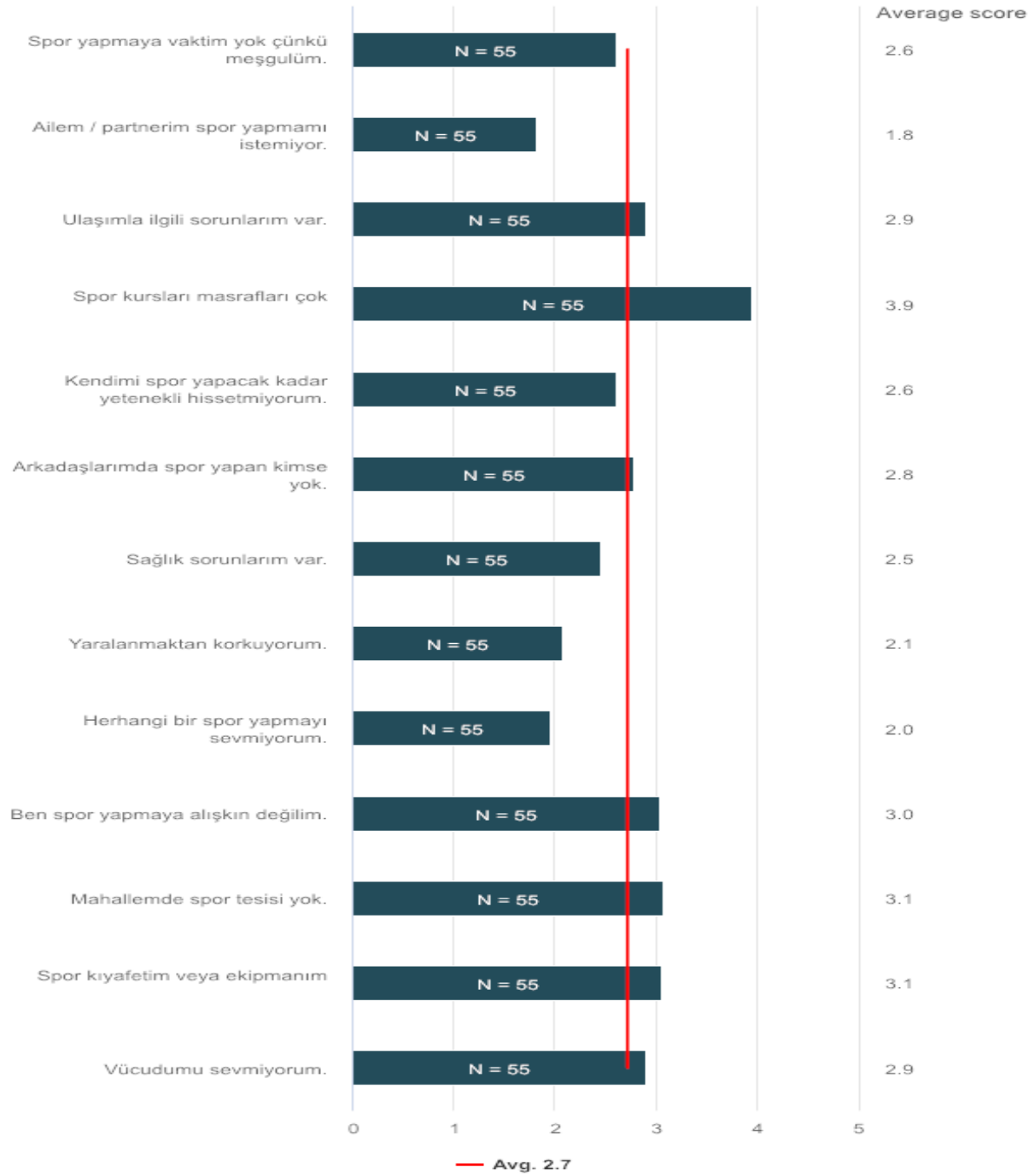

- **PROFILE OF THE PARTICIPANTS**

53 women participated in the first survey, of which 20.8% were aged 20-24, 34% aged 25-29, 28.3% aged 30-34 and 17% older than 35.

The largest share comes from Ljubljana, namely 61.4%, from Maribor 13.2%, from Celje 7.6%, from Koper 3.8%, Novo mesto 3.8%, from Ptuj 1.9%, Tišina 1.9%, Murska Sobota 1.9% and Pšata 1.9%.

- **EDUCATION**

Among the participants, the majority are those who have completed secondary school, namely 45.3%. 35.8% have completed university, 11.3% have completed primary school, 5.7% have a master's or doctorate degree and 1.9% are only literate.

- **EMPLOYMENT**

3.8% own a private company, 13.2% are employed in the private sector, 1.9% are an officer, 11.3% are self-employed, 18.9% are female students, 1.9% are retired, 39.6% pensioners and 9.4% of those who marked the answer Other.

- **MARITAL STATUS**

39.6% of the respondents are single and 60.4% are married.

- **CHILDREN**

34% have no children, 20.8% have one child, 24.5% have two children, 18.9% have three children and 1.9% have more than three children.

- **NUMBER OF PEOPLE LIVING IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD**

When asked how many people live in your household, 28.3% answered that three people. 28.3% said that more than 4 people live in the household together. In 30.2%, four people live in a joint household. 9.2% said that 2 people live together and 3.8% that a person lives alone.

- **MONTHLY INCOME**

22.6% of them receive € 0-400 of monthly income. 41.5% receive between € 400 and € 800, 7.5% receive between € 800 and € 1,100 and 28.3% receive more than € 1,100.

- **DISABILITY**

When asked if they have any disability, 86.8% said no and 13.2% said they do.

- **NATION**

43.3% answered that their citizenship belongs to a different nation than the country in which they now live and 56.6% that their citizenship is the same.

- **EDUCATION BEFORE SURVEY AND WHAT IS IT CONNECTED WITH**

When asked if they had ever been educated or were educated 4 weeks before this survey, 49.1% of them answered no and 50.9% that they had been educated. Those who answered yes, said that this education was related to language courses, study, employment and the employment service. Among those who answered with no says that the reason for this is language incompetence, financial problems, socio-cultural reasons, due to discrimination and exclusion, due to early marriage or other.

- **INFLUENCE OF STUDY CHOICE**

When asked whether they feel influenced or obliged by their socio-cultural environment (family, friends) in choosing study or training, 34% answered that they feel, 18.9% that they feel very, 17% that they feel moderate and 30.2 % that they don't feel it at all.

- **DISCRIMINATION AT UNIVERSITY/ STUDY**

49.1% of participants have never experienced discrimination at university / study because of their gender. 34% experienced such discrimination once, 13.2% two to five times and 3.8% more than five times.

- **WHERE TO FIND OPPORTUNITIES FOR EDUCATION AND EMPLOYMENT**

43.4 claim that they can find or look for opportunities for education and employment within a radius of 0 to 10 km from their home, 35.8% seek it within a radius of more than 10 km from home and 20.8% have to relocate to another city.

- **ACCESS TO DIGITAL TOOLS TO FIND EDUCATION**

1.9% of respondents say they do not have access to digital tools to find education or training opportunities, 47.2% use a laptop and 11.3% a fixed computer. Some use a smartphone or tablet. 13.2% have efficient internet access, 1.9% have partial internet access and 5.7% have offline internet access. 86.8% think that they like searching for information through digital tools for education and training and 13.2% that they do not like such search.

- **UNEMPLOYMENT**

In the last 24 months, 50.9% of all respondents were looking for a job. 52.8% say they have been unemployed for less than 6 months, 3.8% 6 months to one year, 9.4% say they have been unemployed for one year, 13.2% for two years, and 20.8% that they have been unemployed for more than 2 years. 43.4% of all of them have never been employed. To answer why and how their employment ended, in 55.6% they answered that their employer terminated their contract and in 44.4% that they resigned themselves.

- **CAUSES OF UNEMPLOYMENT**

Half of the respondents believe that the main cause of unemployment is the current economic situation at the national and global level. 23.1% believe that socio-cultural reasons are to blame for this, 3.8% that disability or other diseases are to blame for this, and 23.1% believe that re-entering the labor market after long term unemployment is lowering their chances to find new opportunities.

- **DISCRIMINATION IN FINDING A JOB**

59.6% of respondents say they have never experienced discrimination in finding a job because of their gender. 32.7% experienced this once and 7.7% two to five times.

- **ACCESS TO DIGITAL TOOLS TO FIND A JOB**

94.2% have access to digital job search tools, most of them have laptops, landlines, smartphones or tablets. 10% have effective internet access, 2% have partial internet access and 6% have internet access outside. Of all respondents, 92.3% like to search for employment information through digital tools.

- **PROFILE OF THE PARTICIPANTS**

52 women participated in completing the second sport-related survey. 17.3% are 18 to 24 years old, 44.2% are 25 to 34 years old, 26.9% are 35 to 44 years old, 9.6% are 45 to 54 years old and 1.9% are 55 to 64 years old.

Most of them live in Ljubljana, namely 63.5%, followed by Maribor 11.6%, from Murska Sobota 9.6%, Koper 3.8%, Celje 1.9%, Tišina 1.9%, Polhov Gradec 1.9%, Domžale 1.9% and Amsterdam 1.9%.

- **EDUCATION**

36.5% have completed university, 30.8% have completed secondary school, 25.9% have completed grammar school, 3.8% have a master's degree or doctorate and 1.9% are literate.

- **EMPLOYMENT**

25% are employed in the private sector, 19.2% are female students, 9.6% are employed, 3.8% own a private company, 1.9% are retired and 1.9% are unemployed.

- **MONTHLY INCOME**

There are 11.5% of those with a monthly income of less than € 400. 13.5% of respondents have an income of € 400 to € 800, 7.7% have € 800 to € 1,000, 57.7% have € 1,000 to € 1,500 and 9.6% of respondents have more than € 1,500 of monthly income.

- **MARITAL STATUS**

51.9% are married and 48.1% are single.

- **CHILDREN**

46.2% of respondents have children.

- **SPORT**

When asked how they connect with sports as an amateur, 25% of them answered that they are big sports fans, that they try to attend events when they have the opportunity and try to watch sports competitions. 26.9% are interested in sports, they try to watch when they come

across. 38.5% of them say that they are not particularly interested in sports, but if they are watched by family or friends, they also participate and 9.6% are those who are not interested in watching sports events.

15.4% are female athletes who train regularly and participate in competitions. 32.7% are female athletes who exercise regularly but do not take part in competitions, 40.4% are those who engage in sport if the environment is suitable, 5.8% are those who once engaged in sport in recent years, however, they are no longer involved and 5.8% of those who are not interested in sports.

When asked how often they play sports, 7.7% answered that once a month, 9.6% two to three times a month, 32.7% once a week, 21.2% two to three times a week and 28.8% engage in sports four to five times a week.

9.6% have been involved in sports for less than half a year, 19.2% for 6 months to one year, 26.9% for one to three years and 44.2% for more than three years.

They prefer to do sports outside, namely 26.9% on the track suitable for walking or running and 26.9% running outdoors, parks with sports equipment,... 13.5% prefer to practice at home and 32.7% use the gym or a club with a membership system.

They gave their opinions on the following statements and marked them with numbers from 1 to 5, where 1 means I strongly disagree with the statement and 5 I strongly agree with the statement. The first claim was that I play sports to improve my social relationships. 36.5% strongly agree, 21.2% agree, 25% neither agree nor disagree, 13.5% disagree and 3.8% strongly disagree.

The next statement was that they were involved in sports to be healthy. 88.5% strongly agree, 5.8% agree and 5.8% neither agree nor disagree.

When claiming that they play sports because they love it, 42.3% strongly agree, 26.9% agree, 26.9% neither agree nor disagree and 3.8% disagree.

The next claim was that they play sports to differentiate themselves from their friends. 5.8%strongly agree, 3.8% agree, 46.2% neither agree nor disagree, 25% disagree and 19.2% strongly disagree.

On the claim that they are engaged in sports, because it's fun, 69.2% strongly agree, 21.2% agree, and 9.6% neither agree nor disagree.

The next claim was that they play sports because they want to stay in shape. 51.9% of them strongly agree, 34.6% agree, 11.5% neither agree nor disagree and 1.9% disagree.

In the claim that they play sports because they feel better, 86.5% strongly agree, 11.5% agree and 1.9% neither agree nor disagree.

The next claim was that they do not have time for sports because they are too busy. 11.5% strongly agree, 21.2% agree, 34.6% neither agree nor disagree, 11.5% disagree and 21.2% strongly disagree.

In claiming that their family or partner does not want to do sports, 46.2% strongly disagree, 46.2% disagree and 7.7% neither agree nor disagree.

To have problems with transport, 3.8% strongly agree, 3.8% agree, 17.3% neither agree nor disagree, 21.2% disagree and 53.8% strongly disagree.

Most of them agree that the cost of sports courses is too high. 21.2% strongly agree, 32.7% agree, 25% neither agree nor disagree, 13.5% disagree and 7.7% strongly disagree.

The next statement was that they did not feel talented enough in sports. 1.9% strongly agree, also 1.9% agree, 17.3% neither agree nor disagree, 50% disagree and 28.8% strongly disagree.

When claiming that they have someone in friendly sports, 46.2% strongly agree, 30.8% agree, 17.3% neither agree nor disagree and 5.8% strongly disagree.

67.3% strongly disagree that they have health problems, 23.1% disagree, 7.7% neither agree nor disagree and 1.9% that they agree.

The next claim was that they were afraid that would be damaged. 7.7% agree, 15.4% neither agree nor disagree, 36.5% disagree and 40.4% strongly disagree.

In the next statement that they do not like any sport, 5.8% agree, 9.6% neither agree nor disagree, 23.1% disagree and 61.5% strongly disagree.

The next statement was that they are not used to sports. Here, 3.8% strongly agree, 9.6% agree, 19.2% neither agree nor disagree, 28.8% disagree and 38.5% strongly disagree.

Most also strongly disagree that they do not have any sports facility in their neighborhood, namely 61.5% of them, 28.8% disagree, 3.8% neither agree nor disagree, 3.8% agree and 1.9% strongly agree.

When claiming that they do not have sportswear or equipment, 80.8% strongly disagree, 17.3% disagree and 1.9% neither agree nor disagree.

The last claim was that they did not like their bodies. 28.8% strongly disagree, 40.4% disagree, 21.2% neither agree nor disagree and 9.6% disagree.
